

29. EQUAL DEPOSITS

Residential Customers will pay an equal deposit in the amount of:

This equal deposit is based on the average bill of residential customers and is equal to 2/12 of the average annual bill.

30. CALCULATED DEPOSITS

Commercial customers' deposits shall be based upon actual usage of the customer at the same or similar premises for the most recent 12-month period, if such information is available. If usage information is not available, the deposit will be based on the average bills of similar customers and premises in the system. The deposit amount shall not exceed 2/12 of the customer's actual or estimated annual bill where bills are rendered monthly, 3/12 where bills are rendered bimonthly, or 4/12 where bills are rendered quarterly.

F. CLASSIFICATION OF MEMBERS

31. PURPOSE OF CLASSIFICATION

Classification is a means for treating, without discrimination, all members having similar characteristics in their use of service. Special classification will be avoided unless surrounding conditions are so unusual that to apply one of the existing rates or rules would result in serious injustice to either the particular member or to all other members.
