


AFFIDAVIT OF MAILING



Take heart attack symptoms seriously



If you begin experiencing symptoms that could signal a heart attack, it's very important to summon medical assistance by calling 9-1-1 immediately.

Symptoms of a heart attack include:

- Uncomfortable pressure, fullness, squeezing or pain in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or goes away and comes back
- Pain that spreads to the shoulders, neck, jaw, arms or back
- Chest discomfort associated with lightheadedness, fainting, sweating, nausea or shortness of breath
- Abnormal chest pain, stomach or abdominal pain
- Nausea or dizziness
- Shortness of breath and difficulty breathing
- Unexplained anxiety, weakness or fatigue
- Palpitations, cold sweat or paleness
