Enclosed is a fully-executed copy of the proposed Special Contract between Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation and American Municipal Power concerning retail transmission service and backup power for AMP's Smithland Dam facility within JPEC's certified retail electric service territory.

On behalf of JPEC, please submit the Special Contract to the Kentucky Public Service Commission (KPSC) for its review and approval.
