RE: South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation's Community Assistance Resources for Energy Savings Program – DSM-13 (New)

Please find enclosed for filing with the Commission, via the electronic tariff filing system, the above referenced tariff.

South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation is seeking to expand its Demand Side Management (“DSM”) program offerings by introducing the Community Assistance Resources for Energy Savings Program (“CARES”), a common DSM program for utilities across Kentucky and the United States which encourages weatherization and higher efficiency HVAC equipment for low-income, end-use cooperative members (“end-use member”) through the Kentucky Community Action Agency (“CAA”) network of not-for-profit community action agencies. The East Kentucky Power Cooperative (“EKPC”) DSM Steering Committee (“Steering Committee”), a committee of EKPC and owner-member cooperative (“owner-member”) staff, determined that assisting Kentucky’s CAA’s in their weatherization efforts is a worthwhile and economic DSM program. Subsequently, the Steering Committee obtained permission from EKPC executive staff and the owner-member CEOs to implement the CARES program, pending Commission approval.

As part of its May 4th 2015 filing of its CARES program, EKPC provided the California Test results showing that providing low-income end-use members with an incentive to help lower their monthly energy bills is a worthwhile DSM program. This filing by South Kentucky RECC is a direct implementation of that EKPC filing approved by the Commission on June 3, 2015.

Pursuant to KRS 278.180, South Kentucky RECC must give at least 30-days’ notice to the Commission. Therefore, the proposed effective date of this program will be November 1, 2015. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, South Kentucky RECC has posted the requisite notice at its office located at 925-929 North Main Street, Somerset, Kentucky, and will post the requisite notice on its website, no later than five (5) business days from today’s date, which will include a hyperlink to the Commission’s website where the tariff can be found.

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 Section 8, South Kentucky RECC provided notice of this proposed tariff to its end-use members by publishing the same in Kentucky Living Magazine on October 1, 2015.
