

NOTICE

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\$325 will be charged for 5/8" x 3/4" meter connections to proposed water main extensions where the fee is paid prior to the completion date of the construction. This rate is not being changed.

\$700 will be charged for 5/8" x 3/4" meter connections to existing water mains where the fee is paid after the completion of the construction. The proposed rate of \$700 is \$300 (or 75%) higher than the current rate of \$400.

The fee for any larger sized meter will not change and will continue to be charged at the actual cost of installation incurred by the District.

If the PSC does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication or mailing of notice, the PSC may take final action on the tariff filing.
