

NOTICE

The Harrodsburg Water Department has filed a proposed rate schedule with the Public Service Commission which will increase the rates for water service provided to North Mercer Water District and Lake Village Water Association as follows:

The proposed effective date is August 26, 2010. Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged at the current rate. Water flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date will be charged at the new proposed rate.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the Harrodsburg Water Department. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any corporation, association, or person with a substantial interest in the matter may, by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate changes request to intervene. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.
