O R D E R


On October 29, 1990, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") filed a petition for approval of a cellular telephone interconnection agreement. To date, no party that might be affected by approval of the interconnection agreement has filed for or been granted intervention, although a representative of Danbury Cellular Telephone Company participated in an informal conference held on January 7, 1991. In order to assist the Commission in its review and evaluation of the interconnection agreement, and provide ample opportunity for interested parties to comment, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that South Central Bell:

1. Serve all certificated cellular telephone companies with a copy of the interconnection agreement within 10 days from the date of this Order.


2. Advise the cellular telephone companies served with the interconnection agreement that its approval may have substantial impact upon their operations and that they are granted 30 days from the date of this Order to file any comments they consider appropriate with the Commission.
