O R D E R

On February 1, 1993, Advanced Telecommunications Corporation ("ATC") filed a motion requesting relief from responding to items thirteen through twenty of the Commission's January 15, 1993 Order. In support of its motion, ATC states that it has not opposed AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc.'s ("AT&T") petition and intends to participate in this proceeding solely through cross-examination and briefing. As a further basis for its objection, ATC alleges that the information request is burdensome, requires production of sensitive and confidential information, and seeks information of questionable relevance.


The Commission, being sufficiently advised, having considered ATC's motion stating that ATC expects to participate in this proceeding in a limited manner and that responding to Items thirteen through twenty would be burdensome to ATC, HEREBY ORDERS that ATC's motion to be excused from responding to Items thirteen through twenty of the Commission's January 15, 1993 Order is GRANTED.


