O R D E R

On February 7, 2003, the Edmonson County Water District ( Edmonson ) filed proposed tariff revisions to become effective on March 1, 2003. Pursuant to KRS 278.180, tariff revisions may become effective only upon 30 days notice to the Commission, and, therefore, could not become effective until March 9, 2003. However, upon further review, the Commission found that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, additional proceedings were necessary to determine the reasonableness of the revisions. Therefore, this proceeding was established on April 8, 2003.

The proposed tariff language simply clarifies the date for mailing customer bills and the date for mailing delinquency notices.

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, through his Office of Rate Intervention ( AG ), requested and was granted intervention in this proceeding. The AG filed neither comment nor testimony in this proceeding.

Based on the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the tariff revisions proposed by Edmonson on February 7, 2003 are reasonable and should be approved for service on and after the date of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Edmonson's revised tariff language is approved and effective on and after the date of this Order.

2. Within 20 days from the date of this Order, Edmonson shall re-file its tariff pages to reflect the proper effective date.
