ORDER

On December 2, 2016, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention (“AG”), moved the Commission for leave to file his initial requests for information (“Initial Request”) to Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) out of time and to allow him to withdraw his previously filed motion to set a procedural schedule in this matter.

The AG requested intervention in this matter on November 10, 2016. On November 18, 2016, the Commission suspended LG&E’s proposed Gas Line Tracker tariff for five months from January 1, 2017, up to and including June 1, 2017, and set a procedural schedule. On November 21, 2016, the Commission granted the Attorney General’s motion to intervene. On November 29, 2016, the Attorney General requested that the Commission establish a procedural schedule in this matter.

The AG states that he inadvertently missed the November 18, 2016 Order and on November 29, 2016, filed a motion for a procedural schedule to be established. The AG acknowledges that our November 18, 2016 Order established a procedural schedule requiring that initial requests for information to LG&E be filed no later than November 28, 2016. The AG states that due to his oversight of the record, he did not file his Initial

Request until December 2, 2016, which was four days late. The AG requests that in addition to his being allowed to file his Initial Request out of time, LG&E's time to respond should also be extended by four days, and the responses should be due on or before December 16, 2016. The AG states that he has spoken to LG&E's counsel regarding this motion, and that LG&E's counsel does not object.

Having reviewed the AG's motion, the Commission finds that the AG should be allowed to file his Initial Request out of time and to withdraw his motion to set a procedural schedule. The Commission further finds that the procedural schedule previously established should be amended to allow LG&E to respond to the AG's Initial Request on or before December 16, 2016. Finally, the Commission finds that all other provisions of the procedural schedule previously established should be followed as set forth in the Appendix to this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The AG's motion to file his Initial Request out of time and to withdraw his motion to set a procedural schedule is granted.
2. LG&E shall have four additional days to respond to the AG's Initial Request, up to and including December 16, 2016.
3. The procedural schedule established by our November 18, 2016 Order is amended consistent with the above provisions, and as set forth in the Appendix to this Order.
4. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
