Agreement Between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and DigiCell Telecommunications Regarding The Sale of BellSouth Telecommunications Services to DigiCell Telecommunications For The Purposes of Resale

THIS AGREEMENT is by and between **BellSouth Telecommunications**, **Inc.**, ("BellSouth or Company"), a Georgia corporation, and DigiCell Telecommunications ("DigiCell"), a Florida corporation, and shall be deemed effective as of September 16, 1997.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, BellSouth is a local exchange telecommunications company authorized to provide telecommunications services in the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, DigiCell is or seeks to become an alternative local exchange telecommunications company authorized to provide telecommunications services in the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, DigiCell desires to resell BellSouth's telecommunications services; and

WHEREAS, BellSouth has agreed to provide such services to DigiCell for resale purposes and pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual premises and promises contained herein, BellSouth and DigiCell do hereby agree as follows:

I. Term of the Agreement

- A. The term of this Agreement shall be two years beginning September 16, 1997 and shall apply to all of BellSouth's serving territory as of January 1, 1997 in the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee;
- **B.** This Agreement shall be automatically renewed for two additional one year periods unless either party indicates its intent not to renew the Agreement. Notice of such intent must be provided, in writing, to the other party no later than 60 days prior to the end of the then-existing contract period. The terms of this Agreement shall remain in effect after the term of the existing agreement has expired and while a new agreement is being negotiated.
- C. The rates pursuant by which DigiCell is to purchase services from BellSouth for resale shall be at a discount rate off of the retail rate for the telecommunications service. The discount rates shall be as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. Such discount shall reflect the costs avoided by BellSouth when selling a service for wholesale purposes.

II. Definition of Terms

A. CUSTOMER OF RECORD means the entity responsible for placing application for service; requesting additions, rearrangements, maintenance or discontinuance of service; payment in full of charges incurred such as non-recurring, monthly recurring, toll, directory assistance, etc.

- **B.** DEPOSIT means assurance provided by a customer in the form of cash, surety bond or bank letter of credit to be held by the Company.
- **C.** END USER means the ultimate user of the telecommunications services.
- **D.** END USER CUSTOMER LOCATION means the physical location of the premises where an end user makes use of the telecommunications services.
- **E.** NEW SERVICES means functions, features or capabilities that are not currently offered by BellSouth. This includes packaging of existing services or combining a new function, feature or capability with an existing service.
- **F.** OTHER LOCAL EXCHANGE COMPANY (OLEC) means a telephone company certificated by the public service commissions of the Company's franchised area to provide local exchange service within the Company's franchised area.
- **G.** RESALE means an activity wherein a certificated OLEC, such as DigiCell subscribes to the telecommunications services of the Company and then reoffers those telecommunications services to the public (with or without "adding value").
- **H.** RESALE SERVICE AREA means the area, as defined in a public service commission approved certificate of operation, within which an OLEC, such as DigiCell, may offer resold local exchange telecommunications service.

III. General Provisions

A. DigiCell may resell the tariffed local exchange and toll telecommunications services of BellSouth contained in the General Subscriber Service Tariff and Private Line Service Tariff subject to the terms, and conditions specifically set forth herein. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the exclusions and limitations on services available for resale will be as set forth in Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. In addition, DigiCell may not purchase telecommunications services at the wholesale rate for its own use.

BellSouth shall make available telecommunications services for resale at the rates set forth in Exhibit A to this agreement and subject to the exclusions and limitations set forth in Exhibit B to this agreement. It does not however waive its rights to appeal or otherwise challenge any decision regarding resale that resulted in the discount rates contained in Exhibit A or the exclusions and limitations contained in Exhibit B. BellSouth reserves the right to pursue any and all legal and/or equitable remedies, including appeals of any decisions. If such appeals or challenges result in changes in the discount rates or exclusions and limitations, the parties agree that appropriate modifications to this Agreement will be made promptly to make its terms consistent with the outcome of the appeal.

B. The provision of services by the Company to DigiCell does not constitute a joint undertaking for the furnishing of any service.

- C. DigiCell will be the customer of record for all services purchased from BellSouth. Except as specified herein, the Company will take orders from, bill and expect payment from DigiCell for all services.
- **D.** DigiCell will be the Company's single point of contact for all services purchased pursuant to this Agreement. The Company shall have no contact with the end user except to the extent provided for herein.
- **E.** The Company will continue to bill the end user for any services that the end user specifies it wishes to receive directly from the Company.
- **F.** The Company maintains the right to serve directly any end user within the service area of DigiCell. The Company will continue to directly market its own telecommunications products and services and in doing so may establish independent relationships with end users of DigiCell.
- **G.** Neither Party shall interfere with the right of any person or entity to obtain service directly from the other Party.
- **H.** Current telephone numbers may normally be retained by the end user. However, telephone numbers are the property of the Company and are assigned to the service furnished. DigiCell has no property right to the telephone number or any other call number designation associated with services furnished by the Company, and no right to the continuance of service through any particular central office. The Company reserves the right to change such numbers, or the central office designation associated with such numbers, or both, whenever the Company deems it necessary to do so in the conduct of its business.
- **I.** The Company may provide any service or facility for which a charge is not established herein, as long as it is offered on the same terms to DigiCell.
- **J.** Service is furnished subject to the condition that it will not be used for any unlawful purpose.
- **K.** Service will be discontinued if any law enforcement agency advises that the service being used is in violation of the law.
- **L.** The Company can refuse service when it has grounds to believe that service will be used in violation of the law.
- **M.** The Company accepts no responsibility to any person for any unlawful act committed by DigiCell or its end users as part of providing service to DigiCell for purposes of resale or otherwise.
- **N.** The Company will cooperate fully with law enforcement agencies with subpoenas and court orders for assistance with the Company's customers. Law enforcement agency subpoenas and court orders regarding end users of DigiCell will be directed to DigiCell. The Company will bill DigiCell for implementing any requests by law enforcement agencies regarding DigiCell end users.
- **O.** The characteristics and methods of operation of any circuits, facilities or equipment provided by any person or entity other than the Company shall not:

- 1. Interfere with or impair service over any facilities of the Company, its affiliates, or its connecting and concurring carriers involved in its service;
- 2. Cause damage to their plant;
- 3. Impair the privacy of any communications; or
- 4. Create hazards to any employees or the public.
- **P.** DigiCell assumes the responsibility of notifying the Company regarding less than standard operations with respect to services provided by DigiCell.
- **Q.** Facilities and/or equipment utilized by BellSouth to provide service to DigiCell remain the property of BellSouth.
- **R.** White page directory listings will be provided in accordance with regulations set forth in Section A6 of the General Subscriber Service Tariff and will be available for resale.
- **S.** BellSouth will provide customer record information to the DigiCell provided the DigiCell has the appropriate Letter(s) of Authorization. BellSouth may provide customer record information via one of the following methods: US mail, fax, or by electronic interface. BellSouth will provide customer record information via US mail or fax on an interim basis only.

DigiCell agrees to compensate BellSouth for all BellSouth incurred expenditures associated with providing such information to DigiCell. DigiCell will adopt and adhere to the BellSouth guidelines associated with each method of providing customer record information.

- **T.** BellSouth's messaging services may be made available for resale subject to the execution of BellSouth's Messaging Agreement and without the wholesale discount.
- **U.** BellSouth's Inside Wire Maintenance Plans may be made available for resale at rates, terms and conditions as set forth by BellSouth and without the wholesale discount.

IV. BellSouth's Provision of Services to DigiCell

- **A.** DigiCell agrees that its resale of BellSouth services shall be as follows:
 - 1. The resale of telecommunications services shall be limited to users and uses conforming to the class of service restrictions.
 - 2. To the extent DigiCell is a telecommunications carrier that serves greater than 5 percent of the Nation's presubscribed access lines, DigiCell shall not jointly market its interLATA services with the telecommunications services purchased from BellSouth pursuant to this Agreement in any of the states covered under this Agreement. For the purposes of this subsection, to jointly market means any advertisement, marketing effort or billing in which the

telecommunications services purchased from BellSouth for purposes of resale to customers and interLATA services offered by DigiCell are packaged, tied, bundled, discounted or offered together in any way to the end user. Such efforts include, but are not limited to, sales referrals, resale arrangements, sales agencies or billing agreements. This subsection shall be void and of no effect for a particular state covered under this Agreement as of February 8, 1999 or on the date BellSouth is authorized to offer interLATA services in that state, whichever is earlier.

- 3. Hotel and Hospital PBX service are the only telecommunications services available for resale to Hotel/Motel and Hospital end users, respectively. Similarly, Access Line Service for Customer Provided Coin Telephones is the only local service available for resale to Independent Payphone Provider (IPP) customers. Shared Tenant Service customers can only be sold those telecommunications services available in the Company's A23 Shared Tenant Service Tariff.
- 4. DigiCell is prohibited from furnishing both flat and measured rate service on the same business premises to the same subscribers (end users) as stated in A2 of the Company's Tariff except for backup service as indicated in the applicable state tariff Section A3.
- 5. If telephone service is established and it is subsequently determined that the class of service restriction has been violated, DigiCell will be notified and billing for that service will be immediately changed to the appropriate class of service. Service charges for changes between class of service, back billing, and interest as described in this subsection shall apply at the Company's sole discretion. Interest at a rate as set forth in Section A2 of the General Subscriber Service Tariff and Section B2 of the Private Line Service Tariff for the applicable state, compounded daily for the number of days from the back billing date to and including the date that DigiCell actually makes the payment to the Company may be assessed.
- 6. The Company reserves the right to periodically audit services purchased by DigiCell to establish authenticity of use. Such audit shall not occur more than once in a calendar year. DigiCell shall make any and all records and data available to the Company or the Company's auditors on a reasonable basis. The Company shall bear the cost of said audit.
- **B.** Resold services can only be used in the same manner as specified in the Company's Tariff. Resold services are subject to the same terms and conditions as are specified for such services when furnished to an individual end user of the Company in the appropriate section of the Company's Tariffs. Specific tariff features, e.g. a usage allowance per month, shall not be aggregated across multiple resold services. Resold services cannot be used to aggregate traffic from more than one end user customer except as specified in Section A23. of the Company's Tariff referring to Shared Tenant Service.
- **C.** DigiCell may resell services only within the specific resale service area as defined in its certificate.
- **D.** Telephone numbers transmitted via any resold service feature are intended solely for the use of the end user of the feature. Resale of this information is prohibited.
- **E.** No patent, copyright, trademark or other proprietary right is licensed, granted or otherwise transferred by this Agreement. DigiCell is strictly prohibited from any use, including but not limited to sales, marketing or advertising, of any BellSouth name or trademark.

V. Maintenance of Services

- A. DigiCell will adopt and adhere to the standards contained in the applicable BellSouth Work Center Interface Agreement regarding maintenance and installation of service.
- **B.** Services resold under the Company's Tariffs and facilities and equipment provided by the Company shall be maintained by the Company.
- **C.** DigiCell or its end users may not rearrange, move, disconnect, remove or attempt to repair any facilities owned by the Company, other than by connection or disconnection to any interface means used, except with the written consent of the Company.
- **D.** DigiCell accepts responsibility to notify the Company of situations that arise that may result in a service problem.
- **E.** DigiCell will be the Company's single point of contact for all repair calls on behalf of DigiCell's end users. The parties agree to provide one another with toll-free contact numbers for such purposes.
- **F.** DigiCell will contact the appropriate repair centers in accordance with procedures established by the Company.
- **G.** For all repair requests, DigiCell accepts responsibility for adhering to the Company's prescreening guidelines prior to referring the trouble to the Company.
- **H.** The Company will bill DigiCell for handling troubles that are found not to be in the Company's network pursuant to its standard time and material charges. The standard time and material charges will be no more than what BellSouth charges to its retail customers for the same services.
- **I.** The Company reserves the right to contact DigiCell's customers, if deemed necessary, for maintenance purposes.

VI. Establishment of Service

- A. After receiving certification as a local exchange company from the appropriate regulatory agency, DigiCell will provide the appropriate Company service center the necessary documentation to enable the Company to establish a master account for DigiCell. Such documentation shall include the Application for Master Account, proof of authority to provide telecommunications services, an Operating Company Number ("OCN") assigned by the National Exchange Carriers Association ("NECA") and a tax exemption certificate, if applicable. When necessary deposit requirements are met, the Company will begin taking orders for the resale of service.
- **B.** Service orders will be in a standard format designated by the Company.

- C. When notification is received from DigiCell that a current customer of the Company will subscribe to DigiCell's service, standard service order intervals for the appropriate class of service will apply.
- **D.** The Company will not require end user confirmation prior to establishing service for DigiCell's end user customer. DigiCell must, however, be able to demonstrate end user authorization upon request.
- **E.** DigiCell will be the single point of contact with the Company for all subsequent ordering activity resulting in additions or changes to resold services except that the Company will accept a request directly from the end user for conversion of the end user's service from DigiCell to the Company or will accept a request from another OLEC for conversion of the end user's service from the DigiCell to the other LEC. The Company will notify DigiCell that such a request has been processed.
- **F.** If the Company determines that an unauthorized change in local service to DigiCell has occurred, the Company will reestablish service with the appropriate local service provider and will assess DigiCell as the OLEC initiating the unauthorized change, the unauthorized change charge described in F.C.C. Tariff No. 1, Section 13. Appropriate nonrecurring charges, as set forth in Section A4. of the General Subscriber Service Tariff, will also be assessed to DigiCell. These charges can be adjusted if DigiCell provides satisfactory proof of authorization.
- **G.** The Company may, in order to safeguard its interest, require DigiCell to make a deposit to be held by the Company as a guarantee of the payment of rates and charges, unless satisfactory credit has already been established. Any such deposit may be held during the continuance of the service as security for the payment of any and all amounts accruing for the service.
- **H.** Such deposit may not exceed two months' estimated billing.
- I. The fact that a deposit has been made in no way relieves DigiCell from complying with the Company's regulations as to advance payments and the prompt payment of bills on presentation nor does it constitute a waiver or modification of the regular practices of the Company providing for the discontinuance of service for non-payment of any sums due the Company.
- **J.** The Company reserves the right to increase the deposit requirements when, in its sole judgment, the conditions justify such action.
- **K.** In the event that DigiCell defaults on its account, service to DigiCell will be terminated and any deposits held will be applied to its account.
- L. In the case of a cash deposit, interest at a rate as set forth in the appropriate BellSouth tariff shall be paid to DigiCell during the continuance of the deposit. Interest on a deposit shall accrue annually and, if requested, shall be annually credited to DigiCell by the accrual date.

VII. Payment And Billing Arrangements

A. When the initial service is ordered by DigiCell, the Company will establish an accounts receivable master account for DigiCell.

- **B.** The Company shall bill DigiCell on a current basis all applicable charges and credits.
- C. Payment of all charges will be the responsibility of DigiCell. DigiCell shall make payment to the Company for all services billed. The Company is not responsible for payments not received by DigiCell from DigiCell's customer. The Company will not become involved in billing disputes that may arise between DigiCell and its customer. Payments made to the Company as payment on account will be credited to an accounts receivable master account and not to an end user's account.
- **D.** The Company will render bills each month on established bill days for each of DigiCell's accounts.
- **E.** The Company will bill DigiCell, in advance, charges for all services to be provided during the ensuing billing period except charges associated with service usage, which charges will be billed in arrears. Charges will be calculated on an individual end user account level, including, if applicable, any charges for usage or usage allowances. BellSouth will also bill all charges, including but not limited to 911 and E911 charges, telecommunications relay charges, and franchise fees, to DigiCell.
- **F.** The payment will be due by the next bill date (i.e., same date in the following month as the bill date) and is payable in immediately available funds. Payment is considered to have been made when received by the Company.

If the payment due date falls on a Sunday or on a Holiday which is observed on a Monday, the payment due date shall be the first non-Holiday day following such Sunday or Holiday. If the payment due date falls on a Saturday or on a Holiday which is observed on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, the payment due date shall be the last non-Holiday day preceding such Saturday or Holiday. If payment is not received by the payment due date, a late payment penalty, as set forth in I. following, shall apply.

- **G.** Upon proof of tax exempt certification from DigiCell, the total amount billed to DigiCell will not include any taxes due from the end user. DigiCell will be solely responsible for the computation, tracking, reporting and payment of all federal, state and/or local jurisdiction taxes associated with the services resold to the end user.
- **H.** As the customer of record, DigiCell will be responsible for, and remit to the Company, all charges applicable to its resold services for emergency services (E911 and 911) and Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) as well as any other charges of a similar nature.
- If any portion of the payment is received by the Company after the payment due date as set forth preceding, or if any portion of the payment is received by the Company in funds that are not immediately available to the Company, then a late payment penalty shall be due to the Company. The late payment penalty shall be the portion of the payment not received by the payment due date times a late factor. The late factor shall be as set forth in Section A2 of the General Subscriber Service Tariff and Section B2 of the Private Line Service Tariff.
- **J.** Any switched access charges associated with interexchange carrier access to the resold local exchange lines will be billed by, and due to, the Company. No additional charges are to be assessed to DigiCell.

- **K.** The Company will not perform billing and collection services for DigiCell as a result of the execution of this Agreement. All requests for billing services should be referred to the appropriate entity or operational group within the Company.
- **L.** Pursuant to 47 CFR Section 51.617, the Company will bill DigiCell end user common line charges identical to the end user common line charges the Company bills its end users.
- M. In general, the Company will not become involved in disputes between DigiCell and DigiCell's end user customers over resold services. If a dispute does arise that cannot be settled without the involvement of the Company, DigiCell shall contact the designated Service Center for resolution. The Company will make every effort to assist in the resolution of the dispute and will work with DigiCell to resolve the matter in as timely a manner as possible. DigiCell may be required to submit documentation to substantiate the claim.

VIII. Discontinuance of Service

- **A.** The procedures for discontinuing service to an end user are as follows:
 - 1. Where possible, the Company will deny service to DigiCell's end user on behalf of, and at the request of, DigiCell. Upon restoration of the end user's service, restoral charges will apply and will be the responsibility of DigiCell.
 - 2. At the request of DigiCell, the Company will disconnect a DigiCell end user customer.
 - 3. All requests by DigiCell for denial or disconnection of an end user for nonpayment must be in writing.
 - 4. DigiCell will be made solely responsible for notifying the end user of the proposed disconnection of the service.
 - 5. The Company will continue to process calls made to the Annoyance Call Center and will advise DigiCell when it is determined that annoyance calls are originated from one of their end user's locations. The Company shall be indemnified, defended and held harmless by DigiCell and/or the end user against any claim, loss or damage arising from providing this information to DigiCell. It is the responsibility of DigiCell to take the corrective action necessary with its customers who make annoying calls. Failure to do so will result in the Company's disconnecting the end user's service.
- **B.** The procedures for discontinuing service to DigiCell are as follows:
 - 1. The Company reserves the right to suspend or terminate service for nonpayment or in the event of prohibited, unlawful or improper use of the facilities or service, abuse of the facilities, or any other violation or noncompliance by DigiCell of the rules and regulations of the Company's Tariffs.
 - 2. If payment of account is not received by the bill day in the month after the original bill day, the Company may provide written notice to DigiCell, that additional applications for service will be refused and that any pending orders for service will not be completed if payment is not received by

the fifteenth day following the date of the notice. If the Company does not refuse additional applications for service on the date specified in the notice, and DigiCell's noncompliance continues, nothing contained herein shall preclude the Company's right to refuse additional applications for service without further notice.

- 3. If payment of account is not received, or arrangements made, by the bill day in the second consecutive month, the account will be considered in default and will be subject to denial or disconnection, or both.
- 4. If DigiCell fails to comply with the provisions of this Agreement, including any payments to be made by it on the dates and times herein specified, the Company may, on thirty days written notice to the person designated by DigiCell to receive notices of noncompliance, discontinue the provision of existing services to DigiCell at any time thereafter. In the case of such discontinuance, all billed charges, as well as applicable termination charges, shall become due. If the Company does not discontinue the provision of the services involved on the date specified in the thirty days notice, and DigiCell's noncompliance continues, nothing contained herein shall preclude the Company's right to discontinue the provision of the services to DigiCell without further notice.
- 5. If payment is not received or arrangements made for payment by the date given in the written notification, DigiCell's services will be discontinued. Upon discontinuance of service on a DigiCell's account, service to DigiCell's end users will be denied. The Company will also reestablish service at the request of the end user or DigiCell upon payment of the appropriate connection fee and subject to the Company's normal application procedures. DigiCell is solely responsible for notifying the end user of the proposed disconnection of the service.
- 6. If within fifteen days after an end user's service has been denied no contact has been made in reference to restoring service, the end user's service will be disconnected.

IX. Liability

A. The liability of the Company for damages arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, preemptions, delays errors or defects in transmission, or failures or defects in facilities furnished by the Company, occurring in the course of furnishing service or other facilities and not caused by the negligence of DigiCell, or of the Company in failing to maintain proper standards of maintenance and operation and to exercise reasonable supervision shall in no event exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate charge to DigiCell for the period of service during which such mistake, omission, interruption, preemption, delay, error or defect in transmission or defect or failure in facilities occur. The Company shall not be liable for damage arising out of mistakes, omission, interruptions, preemptions, delays, errors or defects in transmission or other injury, including but not limited to injuries to persons or property from voltages or currents transmitted over the service of the Company, (1) caused by customer-provided equipment (except where a contributing cause is the malfunctioning of a Company-provided connecting arrangement, in which event the liability of the Company shall not exceed an amount equal to a proportional amount of the Company billing for the period of service during which such mistake, omission, interruption, preemption, delay, error, defect in transmission or injury occurs), or (2) not prevented by customer-provided equipment but which would have been prevented had Company-provided equipment been used.

- **B.** The Company shall be indemnified and saved harmless by DigiCell against any and all claims, actions, causes of action, damages, liabilities, or demands (including the costs, expenses and reasonable attorneys' fees, on account thereof) of whatever kind or nature that may be made by any third party as a result of the Company's furnishing of service to DigiCell.
- C. The Company shall be indemnified, defended and held harmless by DigiCell and/or the end user against any claim, loss or damage arising from the use of services offered for resale involving:
 - 1. Claims for libel, slander, invasion of privacy or infringement of copyright arising from DigiCell's or end user's own communications.
 - 2. Claims for patent infringement arising from acts combining or using Company services in connection with facilities or equipment furnished by the end user or DigiCell.
 - 3. All other claims arising out of an act or omission of DigiCell or its end user in the course of using services.
- **D.** DigiCell accepts responsibility for providing access for maintenance purposes of any service resold under the provisions of this Tariff. The Company shall not be responsible for any failure on the part of DigiCell with respect to any end user of DigiCell.

X. Treatment of Proprietary and Confidential Information

- A. Both parties agree that it may be necessary to provide each other during the term of this Agreement with certain confidential information, including trade secret information, including but not limited to, technical and business plans, technical information, proposals, specifications, drawings, procedures, customer account data and like information (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Information"). Both parties agree that all Information shall either be in writing or other tangible format and clearly marked with a confidential, private or proprietary legend, or, when the Information is communicated orally, it shall also be communicated that the Information is confidential, private or proprietary. The Information will be returned to the owner within a reasonable time. Both parties agree that the Information shall not be copied or reproduced in any form. Both parties agree to receive such Information and not disclose such Information. Both parties agree to protect the Information received from distribution, disclosure or dissemination to anyone except employees of the parties with a need to know such Information and which employees agree to be bound by the terms of this Section. Both parties will use the same standard of care to protect Information received as they would use to protect their own confidential and proprietary Information.
- **B.** Notwithstanding the foregoing, both parties agree that there will be no obligation to protect any portion of the Information that is either: 1) made publicly available by the owner of the Information or lawfully disclosed by a nonparty to this Agreement; 2) lawfully obtained from any source other than the owner of the Information; or 3) previously known to the receiving party without an obligation to keep it confidential.

XI. Resolution of Disputes

Except as otherwise stated in this Agreement, the parties agree that if any dispute arises as to the interpretation of any provision of this Agreement or as to the proper implementation of this Agreement, the parties will petition the applicable state Public Service Commission for a resolution of the dispute. However, each party reserves any rights it may have to seek judicial review of any ruling made by that Public Service Commission concerning this Agreement.

XII. Limitation of Use

The parties agree that this Agreement shall not be proffered by either party in another jurisdiction as evidence of any concession or as a waiver of any position taken by the other party in that jurisdiction or for any other purpose.

XIII. Waivers

Any failure by either party to insist upon the strict performance by the other party of any of the provisions of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of any of the provisions of this Agreement, and each party, notwithstanding such failure, shall have the right thereafter to insist upon the specific performance of any and all of the provisions of this Agreement.

XIV. **Governing Law**

This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed and enforced in accordance with, the laws of the State of Georgia, without regard to its conflict of laws principles.

XV. **Arm's Length Negotiations**

This Agreement was executed after arm's length negotiations between the undersigned parties and reflects the conclusion of the undersigned that this Agreement is in the best interests of all parties.

XVI. **Notices**

Every notice, consent, approval, or other communications required or contemplated by this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered in person or given by postage prepaid mail, address to:

В. Where specifically required, notices shall be by certified or registered mail. Unless otherwise provided in this Agreement, notice by mail shall be effective on the date it is officially recorded as delivered

by return receipt or equivalent, and in the absence of such record of delivery, it shall be presumed to have been delivered the fifth day, or next business day after the fifth day, after it was deposited in the mails.

XVII. Amendments

This Agreement may be amended at any time upon written agreement of both parties.

XVIII. Entire Agreement

This Agreement sets forth the entire understanding and supersedes prior agreements between the parties relating to the subject matter contained herein and merges all prior discussions between them, and neither party shall be bound by any definition, condition, provision, representation, warranty, covenant or promise other than as expressly stated in this Agreement or as is contemporaneously or subsequently set forth in writing and executed by a duly authorized officer or representative of the party to be bound thereby.

LINE INFORMATION DATA BASE (LIDB) STORAGE AGREEMENT

This Agreement, effective as of September 16, 1997, is entered into by and between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BST"), a Georgia corporation, and DigiCell Telecommunications ("Local Exchange Company"), a Florida corporation, and their fully authorized officers.

WHEREAS, in consideration of the mutual covenants, agreements and obligations set forth below, the parties hereby agree as follows:

I. SCOPE

A. This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions pursuant to which BST agrees to store in its LIDB certain information at the request of the Local Exchange Company and pursuant to which BST, its LIDB customers and Local Exchange Carrier shall have access to such information. Local Exchange Carrier understands that BST provides access to information in its LIDB to various telecommunications service providers pursuant to applicable tariffs and agrees that information stored at the request of Local Exchange Carrier, pursuant to this Agreement, shall be available to those telecommunications service providers. The terms and conditions contained in the attached Addendum No. 1 are hereby made a part of this Agreement as if fully incorporated herein.

- B. LIDB is accessed for the following purposes:
 - 1. Billed Number Screening
 - 2. Calling Card Validation
 - 3. Fraud Control
- C. BST will provide seven days per week, 24-hours per day, fraud control and detection services. These services include, but are not limited to, such features as sorting Calling Card Fraud detection according to domestic or international calls in order to assist the pinpointing of possible theft or fraudulent use of Calling Card numbers; monitoring bill-to-third number and collect calls made to numbers in BST's LIDB, provided such information is included in the LIDB query, and establishing Account Specific Thresholds, at BST's sole discretion, when necessary. Local Exchange Company understands and agrees BST will administer all data stored in the LIDB, including the data provided by Local Exchange Company pursuant to this Agreement, in the same manner as BST's data for BST's end user customers. BST shall not be responsible to Local Exchange Company for any lost revenue which may result from BST's administration of the LIDB pursuant to its established practices and procedures as they exist and as they may be changed by BST in its sole discretion from time to time.

Local Exchange Company understands that BST currently has in effect numerous billing and collection agreements with various interexchange carriers and billing clearing houses. Local Exchange Company further understands that these billing and collection customers of BST query BST's LIDB to determine whether to accept various billing options from end users.

Additionally, Local Exchange Company understands that presently BST has no method to differentiate between BST's own billing and line data in the LIDB and such data which it includes in the LIDB on Local Exchange Company's behalf pursuant to this Agreement.

Therefore, until such time as BST can and does implement in its LIDB and its supporting systems the means to differentiate Local Exchange Company's data from BST's data and the parties to this Agreement execute appropriate amendments hereto, the following terms and conditions shall apply:

- (a) The Local Exchange Company agrees that it will accept responsibility for telecommunications services billed by BST for its billing and collection customers for Local Exchange Customer's end user accounts which are resident in LIDB pursuant to this Agreement. Local Exchange Company authorizes BST to place such charges on Local Exchange Company's bill from BST and agrees that it shall pay all such charges. Charges for which Local Exchange Company hereby takes responsibility include, but are not limited to, collect and third number calls.
- (b) Charges for such services shall appear on a separate BST bill page identified with the name of the entity for which BST is billing the charge.
- (c) Local Exchange Company shall have the responsibility to render a billing statement to its end users for these charges, but Local Exchange Company's obligation to pay BST for the charges billed shall be independent of whether Local Exchange Company is able or not to collect from the Local Exchange Company's end users.
- (d) BST shall not become involved in any disputes between Local Exchange Company and the entities for which BST performs billing and collection. BellSouth will not issue adjustments for charges billed on behalf of an entity to Local Exchange Company. It shall be the responsibility of the Local Exchange Company and the other entity to negotiate and arrange for any appropriate adjustments.

II. TERM

This Agreement will be effective as of September 16, 1997, and will continue in effect for one year, and thereafter may be continued until terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.

III. FEES FOR SERVICE AND TAXES

- A. The Local Exchange Company will not be charged a fee for storage services provided by BST to the Local Exchange Company, as described in Section I of this Agreement.
- B. Sales, use and all other taxes (excluding taxes on BST's income) determined by BST or any taxing authority to be due to any federal, state or local taxing jurisdiction with respect to the provision of the service set forth herein will be paid by the Local Exchange Company. The Local Exchange Company shall have the right to have BST contest with the imposing jurisdiction, at the Local Exchange Company's expense, any such taxes that the Local Exchange Company deems are improperly levied.

IV. INDEMNIFICATION

To the extent not prohibited by law, each party will indemnify the other and hold the other harmless against any loss, cost, claim, injury, or liability relating to or arising out of negligence or willful misconduct by the indemnifying party or its agents or contractors in connection with the indemnifying party's provision of services, provided, however, that any indemnity for any loss, cost, claim, injury or liability arising out of or relating to errors or omissions in the provision of services under this Agreement shall be limited as otherwise specified in this Agreement. The indemnifying party under this Section agrees to defend any suit

brought against the other party for any such loss, cost, claim, injury or liability. The indemnified party agrees to notify the other party promptly, in writing, of any written claims, lawsuits, or demands for which the other party is responsible under this Section and to cooperate in every reasonable way to facilitate defense or settlement of claims. The indemnifying party shall not be liable under this Section for settlement by the indemnified party of any claim, lawsuit, or demand unless the defense of the claim, lawsuit, or demand has been tendered to it in writing and the indemnifying party has unreasonably failed to assume such defense.

V. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Neither party shall be liable to the other party for any lost profits or revenues or for any indirect, incidental or consequential damages incurred by the other party arising from this Agreement or the services performed or not performed hereunder, regardless of the cause of such loss or damage.

VI. MISCELLANEOUS

- A. It is understood and agreed to by the parties that BST may provide similar services to other companies.
- B. All terms, conditions and operations under this Agreement shall be performed in accordance with, and subject to, all applicable local, state or federal legal and regulatory tariffs, rulings, and other requirements of the federal courts, the U. S. Department of Justice and state and federal regulatory agencies. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to cause either party to violate any such legal or regulatory requirement and either party's obligation to perform shall be subject to all such requirements.
- C. The Local Exchange Company agrees to submit to BST all advertising, sales promotion, press releases, and other publicity matters relating to this Agreement wherein BST's

corporate or trade names, logos, trademarks or service marks or those of BST's affiliated companies are mentioned or language from which the connection of said names or trademarks therewith may be inferred or implied; and the Local Exchange Company further agrees not to publish or use advertising, sales promotions, press releases, or publicity matters without BST's prior written approval.

- D. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Local Exchange Company and BST which supersedes all prior agreements or contracts, oral or written representations, statements, negotiations, understandings, proposals and undertakings with respect to the subject matter hereof.
- E. Except as expressly provided in this Agreement, if any part of this Agreement is held or construed to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity of any other Section of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect to the extent permissible or appropriate in furtherance of the intent of this Agreement.
- F. Neither party shall be held liable for any delay or failure in performance of any part of this Agreement for any cause beyond its control and without its fault or negligence, such as acts of God, acts of civil or military authority, government regulations, embargoes, epidemics, war, terrorist acts, riots, insurrections, fires, explosions, earthquakes, nuclear accidents, floods, strikes, power blackouts, volcanic action, other major environmental disturbances, unusually severe weather conditions, inability to secure products or services of other persons or transportation facilities, or acts or omissions of transportation common carriers.
- G. This Agreement shall be deemed to be a contract made under the laws of the State of Georgia, and the construction, interpretation and performance of this Agreement and all transactions hereunder shall be governed by the domestic law of such State.

Optional Daily Usage File Agreement

SECTION 1. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

1.01 This agreement shall apply to the service of the Optional Daily Usage File (ODUF) as provided by BellSouth to Reseller, ("CLEC-1"). The specifications, terms and conditions for the provisions of this service are outlined in the Exhibit A to this Agreement.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

2.01

- A. <u>Compensation</u> is the amount of money due from CLEC-1 to BellSouth for services provided under this Agreement.
- B. Optional Daily Usage File (ODUF) is the compilation of messages or copies of messages in standard Exchange Message Interface (EMI) format exchanged from BellSouth to CLEC-1.
- C. <u>Exchange Message Interface</u> is the nationally administered standard format for the exchange of data within the telecommunications industry.
- D. <u>Message Distribution</u> is routing determination and subsequent delivery of message data from one company to another.

SECTION 3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

- 3.01 ODUF service provided to CLEC-1 by BellSouth will be in accordance with the methods and practices regularly adopted and applied by BellSouth to its own operations during the term of this agreement, including such revisions as may be made from time to time by BellSouth.
- 3.02 CLEC-1 shall furnish all relevant information required by BellSouth for the provision of the Optional Daily Usage File.

SECTION 4. COMPENSATION ARRANGEMENTS

4.01 Applicable compensation amounts will be billed by BellSouth to CLEC-1 on a monthly basis in arrears. Amounts due from CLEC-1 to BellSouth (excluding adjustments) are payable within 30 days of the date of the billing statement.

SECTION 5. ASSOCIATED EXHIBIT

5.01 Listed below is the exhibit associated with this Agreement, incorporated herein by this reference.

Exhibit A Optional Daily Usage File (ODUF)

5.02 From time to time by written agreement of the parties, new exhibits may be substituted for the attached Exhibit A, superseding and canceling the Exhibit(s) then in effect.

SECTION 6. TERM OF AGREEMENT

6.01 This Agreement and its attachment(s) are effective August 24, 1998 and will continue in force until terminated, with or without cause, by thirty (30) days prior notice in writing from either party to the other. This Agreement may be amended from time to time upon written agreement of the parties.

1. Scope of the Exhibit

1.1 Upon written request from CLEC-1, BellSouth will provide the Optional Daily Usage File service to CLEC-1 pursuant to the rates, terms and conditions set forth in this exhibit.

2. General Information

- 2.1 CLEC-1 shall furnish all relevant information required by BellSouth for the provision of the Optional Daily Usage File.
- 2.2 The Optional Daily Usage File will contain billable messages, that were carried over the BellSouth Network and processed in the CRIS Billing System, but billing to a CLEC-1 customer. The Optional Daily Usage Feed also includes operator handled calls originating from CLEC-1 subscriber lines and purchasing Operator Services from BellSouth. Charges for delivery of the Optional Daily Usage File will appear on CLEC-1's monthly bills. Charges for the ODUF will be as follows:

2.3 All messages provided with the Optional Daily Usage File will be in the standard Bellcore EMI record format.

2.4 Messages that error in the billing system of CLEC-1 will be the responsibility of CLEC-1. If, however, CLEC-1 should encounter significant volumes of errored messages that prevent processing by CLEC-1 within its systems, BellSouth will work with CLEC-1 to determine the source of the errors and the appropriate resolution.

3. Usage To Be Transmitted

- 3.1 The following messages recorded by BellSouth will be transmitted to CLEC-1:
 - message recording for per use/per activation type services (examples: Three Way Calling, Verify, Interrupt, Call Return, ETC.)
 - measured billable Local
 - Directory Assistance messages
 - intraLATA Toll
 - WATS & 800 Service
- 3.2 Rated Incollects (originated in BellSouth and from other companies) can also be on ODUF. Rated Incollects will be intermingled with BellSouth recorded rated and unrated usage. Rated Incollects will not be packed separately.
- 3.3 BellSouth will perform duplicate record checks on records processed to the Optional Daily Usage File. Any duplicate messages detected will be dropped and not sent to CLEC-1.
- 3.4 In the event that CLEC-1 detects a duplicate on the Optional Daily Usage File they receive from BellSouth, CLEC-1 will drop the duplicate message (CLEC will not return the duplicate to BellSouth).

4. File Characteristics and Transmission Method

4.1 The Optional Daily Usage Feed will be distributed to CLEC-1 via an agreed upon medium with CONNECT:Direct being the preferred transport method. The ODUF will be a variable block format (2476) with an LRECL of 2472. The data on the ODUF will be in a non-compacted EMI format (175 byte format plus modules). It will be created on a daily basis (Monday through Friday except holidays). Details such as dataset name and delivery schedule will be addressed during negotiations of the distribution medium. There will be one dataset per workday.

4.2 Data circuits (private line or dial-up) may be required between BellSouth and CLEC-1 for the purpose of data transmission. Where a dedicated line is required, CLEC-1 will be responsible for ordering the circuit, overseeing its installation and coordinating the installation with BellSouth. CLEC-1 will also be responsible for any charges associated with this line. Equipment required on the BellSouth end to attach the line to the mainframe computer and to transmit successfully ongoing will be negotiated on a case by case basis. Where a dial-up facility is required, dial circuits will be installed in the BellSouth data center by BellSouth and the associated charges assessed to CLEC-1. Additionally, all message toll charges associated with the use of the dial circuit by CLEC-1 will be the responsibility of CLEC-1. Associated equipment on the BellSouth end, including a modem, will be negotiated on a case by case basis between the parties. All equipment, including modems and software, that is required on CLEC-1 end for the purpose of data transmission will be the responsibility of CLEC-1.

5. Packing Specifications

- 5.1 A pack will contain a minimum of one message record or a maximum of 99,999 message records plus a pack header record and a pack trailer record. One transmission can contain a maximum of 99 packs and a minimum of one pack.
- 5.2 The Operating Company Number (OCN), From Revenue Accounting Office (RAO), and Invoice Number will control the invoice sequencing. The From RAO will be used to identify to CLEC-1 which BellSouth RAO is sending the message. BellSouth and CLEC-1 will use the invoice sequencing to control data exchange. BellSouth will be notified of sequence failures identified by CLEC-1 and resend the data as appropriate.

The data will be packed using Bellcore EMI records.

6. Pack Rejection

6.1 CLEC-1 will notify BellSouth within one business day of rejected packs (via the mutually agreed medium). Packs could be rejected because of pack sequencing discrepancies or a critical edit failure on the Pack Header or Pack Trailer records (i.e. out-of-balance condition on grand totals, invalid data populated). CLEC-1 will not be required to return the actual rejected data to BellSouth. Rejected packs will be corrected and/or retransmitted to CLEC-1 by BellSouth.

7. Control Data

CLEC-1 will send one confirmation record per pack that is received from BellSouth. This confirmation record will indicate CLEC-1 received the pack and the acceptance or rejection of the pack. Pack status Code(s) will be populated using standard Bellcore EMI codes for packs that were rejected by CLEC-1 for reasons stated in the above section.

8. Testing

8.1 BellSouth shall send test file(s) to CLEC-1 for the Optional Daily Usage File. The parties agree to review and discuss the file's content and/or format. For testing of usage results, BellSouth shall request that CLEC-1 set up a production (LIVE) file. The live test may consist of the CLEC-1's employees making test calls for the types of services that CLEC-1 wants to see on the ODUF. These test calls are logged by CLEC-1, and the logs are provided to BellSouth. The logs will be used to verify the files.
