- 1. The Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") previously established in this matter a procedural schedule providing for and these parties have prefiled direct and rebuttal testimony. The matter is currently scheduled for hearing on February 22, 2005.
- 2. NuVox and Kentucky ALLTEL were the only parties to file cost studies and testimony in this proceeding.
