

expected completion by the summer of 2003. The building will likely be four to six stories tall, and not obstruct the view of the city from the park at Fort Hill.

Patton said he wanted a building that would complement downtown Frankfort.

"I think we ought to have a building that is compatible with the rest of the community and not just a box with four walls and a roof," the governor said.

Patton also said he wanted state government to spruce up its properties downtown and suggested getting rid of the old state Water Patrol building on the corner of High and Mero streets. That building is a concrete block structure.

"We have a responsibility to make sure our presence in the city enhances the city ... this particular area of Frankfort is going to be dramatically improved," Patton said.

Building the Transportation Cabinet headquarters on Mero Street will require the demolition or removal of several historic properties. Patton said state officials are working with the Kentucky Heritage Council to address those issues.

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David Morgan, state historic preservation officer and executive director of the Heritage Council, said at least two structures in the path of the project should be moved.

A few buildings in the area were constructed around the time of the Civil War. Those include the Simon Furniture building and a large brick house on Ann Street.
