ORDER

On May 13, 1999, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") filed with the Commission its application seeking a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to qualify it to bid on a combined electric and gas franchise in the city of Broadfields, Kentucky. Under the provisions of KRS 278.020(3), no utility may apply for a franchise from any governmental agency until it has obtained a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity from this Commission based on our finding that there is a need and demand for the service sought to be rendered.

The Commission determines that there is evidence of a need and demand for gas and electric service in the above-mentioned city. Since the Commission's authority in such matters is limited by statute to finding only whether there is a need and demand for the service sought to be rendered, no finding or determination is made as to the qualifications of the bidder, the validity of any of the provisions of the franchises offered by said city, or the manner in which any franchise fee is to be treated for rate purposes.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. LG&E is granted a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity that authorizes it to bid on a combined electric and gas franchise in the above-mentioned city.

2. LG&E, if it becomes the successful bidder, shall file with this Commission two copies of the franchise agreement.

3. This Order shall not be construed as granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to construct utility facilities in said city.

Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") hereby requests that the Public Service Commission issue a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, pursuant to KRS 278.020(3), to allow it to bid on a franchise for electric and natural gas service in the City of Broadfields, Kentucky ("Broadfields").

1. The post office address of the principal office of LG&E is 200 W. Main St., P.O. Box 32010, Louisville, Kentucky 40232. LG&E has previously provided the Commission with a copy of its Articles of Incorporation and amendments thereto in its Application in Case No. 97-300.

2. LG&E currently holds a franchise from Broadfields that permits it to place its wires, poles, mains and other pipes and equipment in, on, and across the property and rights-of-way of Broadfields for the purpose of providing electric and natural gas service to its customers within the municipal boundaries of Broadfields. This franchise terminated under its terms on April 16, 1999. Broadfields' City Council has passed an ordinance creating a new franchise to

replace the existing LG&E franchise and has commenced publication of a Notice of Sale of Franchise.

3. LG&E provides electric and natural gas service to approximately 300 customers within the municipal boundaries of Broadfields under rates, terms, and conditions regulated by this Commission. As evidenced by this number of customers, there is a continuing need and demand for electric and natural gas service within Broadfields. LG&E desires to submit a bid for a new franchise that will replace its current franchise to provide electric and natural gas service in Broadfields. LG&E will provide the Commission with a copy of its new franchise after it procures the same.

WHEREFORE, Louisville Gas and Electric Company respectfully requests that the Commission issue it a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for it to bid on a franchise for electric and natural gas service in the City of Broadfields, Kentucky.
