On June 21, 1999, SBA Towers, Inc. ("SBA") and GTE Wireless of the Midwest Incorporated (collectively, the "Applicants") filed an application seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a wireless telecommunications facility. The proposed facility is to be located at 220 Mt. Zion-Crittenden Road, Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky. The coordinates for the proposed facility are North Latitude 38° 45' 46.64" by West Longitude 84° 36' 25.12".

SBA has provided information regarding the structure of the tower, safety measures, and antenna design criteria for the proposed facility. Based upon the application, the design of the tower and foundation conforms to applicable nationally recognized building standards, and the plans have been certified by a Registered Professional Engineer. Pursuant to KRS 100.987, the Applicants have submitted a copy of the uniform application to the Grant County Planning Commission ("Planning Commission"). The Planning Commission intervened in this proceeding pending its review of the proposal. The Planning Commission later filed comments stating that it had approved the proposed construction. The Applicants have filed applications with the Federal Aviation Administration and the Kentucky Airport Zoning Commission seeking approval for the construction and operation of the proposed facility. Both applications have been approved.

The Applicants have filed evidence of the appropriate notices provided pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063. The notices solicited any comments and informed the recipients of their right to request intervention. The Commission received comments from nearby property owners but no requests for intervention or a public hearing were filed.

Pursuant to KRS 278.280, the Commission is required to determine proper practices to be observed when it finds, upon complaint or on its own motion, that the facilities of any utility subject to its jurisdiction are unreasonable, unsafe, improper, or insufficient. To assist the Commission in its efforts to comply with this mandate, SBA should notify the Commission if it does not use this antenna tower to provide service in the manner set out in its application and this Order. Upon receipt of such notice, the Commission may, on its own motion, institute proceedings to consider the proper practices, including removal of the unused antenna tower, which should be observed by SBA.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that the Applicants have demonstrated that a facility is necessary

to provide adequate utility service and therefore should be granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct the proposed facility.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. SBA is granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a wireless telecommunications facility to be located at 220 Mt. Zion-Crittenden Road, Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky. The coordinates for the proposed facility are North Latitude 38° 45' 46.64" by West Longitude 84° 36' 25.12".

2. SBA shall immediately notify the Commission in writing, if, after the antenna tower is built and utility service is commenced, the tower is not used for a period of 3 months in the manner authorized by this Order.

On June 21, 1999 the Grant County Planning Commission received an application from SBA Towers, Inc. / GTE Wireless (6001 Broken Sound Parkway 4th Floor – Boca Raton, FL 33487), to construct a communications facility ("tower") at 220 Crittenden-Mt. Zion Road, Crittenden, Grant County, Kentucky.

The Grant County Planning Commission met on August 16, 1999 to review SBA Towers, Inc. / GTE Wireless's application and will make the recommendation of approval for this site with the following conditions:

- 1. The communications facility ("tower") have a permitted height of 300 feet (with possible adjustment to 350 feet).
- 2. The communications facility ("tower") have at least one parking space.
- 3. The communications facility ("tower") have all access drives and parking spaces paved with asphalt.
- 4. The communications facility ("tower") use barbwire on the top of the fences and slats within the chain links for privacy when building the compound.
- 5. The communications facility ("tower") have landscaping on all four sides of the compound.
- 6. A written agreement between SBA Towers, Inc. / GTE Wireless and the local governing body for the upkeep of all landscaping and equipment.

ITEM 1. TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER - 220 CRITTENDEN MT. ZION RD. - SBA/GTE

Chairman, John Lawrence declared the public hearing open at 7:20.

Sandy Keene stated that the tower they were asking for would be 315 ft. max with FAA approval to 350 ft. She stated that there were no 300 ft. within their search ring, there was a 150 ft. water tower which would not accommodate their needs and there was plans of a Crown tower but no one with Crown knew anything about this tower. She stated that approximately 1 mile away SprintCom had applied for a 250 ft. tower which was not approved yet and would not meet their needs if approved.

Mrs. Keene stated that they were asking for 3 waivers: 1. asking to build the tower to a height of 300 ft. 2. to waive the paving requirement of the off street drive and parking, she said that the existing gravel drive is sufficient for access and construction. 3. to waive the landscaping requirement.

The Commission asked to see a site plan of the tower to better know exactly where the site was.

Mrs. Keen stated that that was part of the uniform application which was confidential and she did not want the violate any laws.

Ken Rylee stated that the statute says that all parts of the application are confidential except anything that identified the location of the proposed facility.

After further discussion the commission reviewed a copy of the site plan.

Chairman, John Lawrence asked if anyone wished to speak for or against this request.

No one spoke for or against.

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Steven Mann questioned that even thought the tower is located on an A1 piece of the land that it borders 3 businesses one of which is a daycare, and concern was that the children may get into the facility.

Mrs. Keene stated that the usual place for the towers is around businesses and that children would not be able to get into the facility.

Chairman, John Lawrence questions what happens if the tower is no longer in use in the future.

Mrs. Keene stated that it is in the lease agreement that the tower would be taken down if no longer used.

The Commission questioned possible co-location of SprintCom and GTE because their towers were a mile apart and questioned if this site is approved would they try to co-located with SprintCom

Mrs. Keene stated that if this site is approved they would probably not try to co-locate and the SprintCom tower would not meet their needs because it is only 250 ft. tall and is further north.

John Lawrence declared the public hearing closed at 8:00.

The commission discussed the waivers and decided that they wanted landscaping, proper fence height and wanted pavement instead of gravel.

Mrs. Keene stated that they would meet the fence height requirements, would pave the access drive and parking and would landscape the facility.

Vernon Webster made a motion to approve the application allowing the tower to be built to 300 ft. and expandable to 350 with FAA approval. Marvin Faulkner seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken: Vernon Webster: yes, Robert Worthington: yes, Sam Womble: yes, William Covington: yes, Marvin Faulkner: yes, Steven Mann: yes, Brooke Wooton: yes, Jim Weigel: yes. Motion passes 8 to 0.
