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



<u>ORDER</u>

On July 2, 1999, West Carroll County Water District ("West Carroll") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. West Carroll purchases its water from four suppliers: Trimble County Water District No. 1 ("Trimble County"), Henry County Water, City of Milton Water, and Carrollton Utilities.

2. Trimble County increased the wholesale water rate charged to West Carroll from \$1.25 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.74 per 1,000 gallons purchased, effective March 5, 1999. The other three suppliers did not increase their rates.

3. During the 12 months ending April 30, 1999, West Carroll purchased a total of 71,890,070 gallons of water and sold 48,036,900 gallons.

4. The increase in the cost of purchased water will be \$7,961.13, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons of water. Based on a monthly

usage of 5,000 gallons, the average bill of a West Carroll customer would increase \$0.85 from \$36.50 to \$37.35 or 2.3 percent.

5. The calculations and tariff provided by West Carroll are correct and should be approved.

6. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A are approved for services rendered on and after August 1, 1999.

2. The tariff submitted by West Carroll is hereby approved as filed.

3. Within 20 days from the effective date of this Order, West Carroll shall file a copy of the notice to its customers and verification that such notice has been given.

ORDER

On November 23, 1998, Trimble County Water District No. 1 ("Trimble County") filed its application for Commission approval of proposed water rates. The proposed rates would generate additional annual revenues of \$185,777.

Commission Staff performed a limited financial review of Trimble County's operations, and issued a Staff Report on January 28, 1999, recommending that Trimble County be allowed to increase its annual operating revenues by the requested amount of \$185,777, or 60.09 percent. This results in an increase of 50.05 percent on the average customer bill.

By Order dated January 28, 1999, the Commission advised Trimble County that comments on the Staff Report or requests for a public hearing must be submitted no later than February 8, 1999, or 90 days from the date the application was filed, or this case would stand submitted to the Commission for decision. Trimble County filed its response in agreement with the Staff Report on February 2, 1999. No additional comments or requests for a hearing have been filed.

The Commission, after considering the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. The recommendations and findings contained in the Staff Report are adopted as the Commission's findings and incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.

2. The rates in Appendix A will produce gross annual water revenue of \$494,952 and are the fair, just, and reasonable rates for Trimble County. These rates will allow Trimble County sufficient revenues to meet its operating expenses, and provide for future equity growth, including provisions for servicing its debt.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Trimble County and contained in Appendix A are approved for service rendered by Trimble County on and after the date of this Order.

 Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Trimble County shall file with the Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates approved herein.
