#### ORDER

On August 3, 1999, Cawood Water District ("Cawood") applied to the Commission for authority to revise its 5/8" x 3/4" meter connection charge. Cawood requested permission to deviate from the filing requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8, and Section 10 (1)(b), (1)(c), (1)(d), (1)(e) and (2).

On August 19, 1999, the Commission issued an Order granting Cawood's request to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8, and Section 10(1)(e). Cawood was notified by letter dated August 19, 1999 of filing deficiencies in its application, and that the statutory time period in which the Commission must process the case would not commence until the required information was filed. Cawood updated its application on August 24, 1999, curing the deficiencies and the case was considered filed on August 27, 1999.

The proposed revision to Cawood's 5/8" x 3/4" meter connection charge increased the amount from \$300.00 to \$550.00. Cawood provided adequate cost justification for the non-recurring charge proposed in the application. Increased costs of materials and labor was the basis for the increase.

After reviewing the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. The proposed charges are equal to the expenses incurred to provide the associated services.
- 2. The charges set forth in Appendix A of this Order, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The charges in Appendix A are approved for services rendered on and after the date of this Order.
- 2. Within 30 days of the date of this order, Cawood shall file its revised tariff sheet setting out the charges approved in this Order.

Due to increases in the costs of the materials, equipment, and labor required to install new taps (meter settings) the Cawood Water District is requesting approval of the attached amended tariff. The amended tariff will change the connection charge (tap fee) for a 5/8" x 3/4" meter setting from \$300.00 to \$550.00. The connection charge for all other size meters will be changed from \$300.00 to the actual cost of the materials, equipment, and labor including overhead required to install the meter. The District has not changed its connection charges since its original system installation in 1989.

The District is also requesting a deviation pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 Section 14 from the requirements in 407 KAR 5:011 Section 10 (1)(b), (1)(c), (1)(d), (1)(e) and (2) on the grounds that the connection charges (tap fees) are revenue neutral, nonrecurring charges. The requested tap fee will allow the District to "break even" on installing new water services and will keep the District from losing money. #### ORDER

On August 3, 1999, Cawood Water District ("Cawood") applied to the Commission for authority to adjust its non-recurring connection charges. In its filing, Cawood requested permission to deviate from the requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8 and Section 10(1)(e).

Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8, requires that a copy of the public notice be included in the filing. Section 10(1)(e) requires the submission of an income statement and balance sheet for a recent 12-month period.

Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that no existing customers will be affected by the proposed rate change since connection charges are imposed only once, when service is first initiated to a new location. The information filed by Cawood is sufficient to enable the Commission to review adequately Cawood's filing. Therefore, its request to deviate from the above-cited regulations should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Cawood's request to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8 and 10(1)(e), is granted.
