On August 2, 1999, Hendron Water District ("Hendron District") petitioned the Commission to fill, pursuant to KRS 74.020(4),<sup>1</sup> a vacancy on its Board of Commissioners. Since the filing of that petition, the McCracken County Judge/Executive has appointed, with the approval of the McCracken County Fiscal Court, Robert Dreher to fill this vacancy. This action renders Hendron District's petition moot.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Hendron District's petition is denied on the grounds of mootness.
- 2. This matter is closed and shall be removed from the Commission's docket.

Dear Judge Orazine:

On July 30, 1999, the Hendron Water District ("Hendron District") applied to the Public Service Commission for the reappointment of Mr. Bob Dreher to its Board of Commissioners. Enclosed is a copy of this application.

In support of its application, Hendron District referred to KRS 74.020(4) that provides:

Vacancies [to a water district's board of commissioners] shall be filled by the same appointing authority which is empowered to make the original appointment. Vacancies resulting from cause other than expiration of the term shall be filled for the unexpired term only. Notwithstanding the provisions of KRS 67.710, a vacancy resulting from the expiration of a term shall be filled by the Public Service Commission if, within ninety (90) days following the expiration of the term, the vacancy has not been filled by the appropriate county judge/executive with approval of the fiscal court.

As Mr. Dreher's current term as a commissioner expired on March 31, 1999, and no successor had been appointed and approved, KRS 74.020(4) authorizes the Public Service Commission to make the requested appointment.

During the course of this proceeding, the Public Service Commission has discovered that Hendron District did not notify the McCracken County Judge/Executive of the expiration of Mr. Dreher's term as required by KRS 65.008(1).<sup>1</sup> The record of this proceeding fails to indicate whether the McCracken County Judge/Executive or McCracken County Fiscal Court was aware of the vacancy created by the expiration of Mr. Dreher's term.

Before proceeding to a decision on Hendron District's application, the Public Service Commission wishes to advise you of this proceeding and to requests that you advise it within 20 days of this letter of your intentions in this matter. For your reference, I am enclosing a copy of the Public Service Commission's Rules of Procedure should you wish to intervene in this matter. The Public Service Commission further requests that, should you and McCracken County Fiscal Court take some action on this vacancy, you advise it of the action taken.

### **COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER**

In compliance with the Order of the Public Service Commission ("PSC") dated October 21, 1999, the Hendron Water District ("Hendron District") states as follows:

1. Provide a certified copy of the order of the McCracken County Judge/Executive appointing Bob Dreher to his most recent term as a member of the Hendron District Board of Commissioners.

RESPONSE: A certified copy of the McCracken County Fiscal Court Order appointing Bobby Dreher as a Commissioner of the Hendron Water District is attached hereto. On March 13, 1995, Mr. Dreher was reappointed to a four-year term as a Commissioner of the Hendron District beginning April 1, 1995, and ending March 31, 1999. Responsible witness: Don Peck, Chairman.

2. a. Provide the notification that Hendron District provided to the McCracken County Judge/Executive of the expiration of Mr. Dreher's term office.

b. State when Hendron District provided notification of the forthcoming expiration of Mr. Dreher's term of office.

c. If Hendron District failed to provide prior notification of the expiration of Mr. Dreher's term of office, explain why.

#### **RESPONSE:**

a. There was no notification from the Hendron District to the McCracken County Judge Executive of the expiration of Mr. Dreher's term. Typically, the notification of a reappointment is initiated by the Judge Executive. The Judge Executive's administrative assistant calls the Commissioner and asks if the Commissioner is willing to serve another term. In this case, Mr. Dreher returned a telephone call to the Judge Executive's office in March 1999 and was informed that the message for him to call had been a mistake. Responsible witness: Don Peck and Bob Dreher.

b. Hendron District did not provide any notification of the forthcoming expiration of Mr. Dreher's term. Responsible witness: Don Peck.

c. Hendron District does not typically provide prior notification of the expiration of a commissioner's term of office. As stated above, the Judge Executive's office typically initiates the notification to the individual commissioner. Responsible witness: Don Peck.

3. Provide all correspondence between the McCracken County Judge/Executive and Hendron District or Hendron District's commissioners regarding the appointment of a successor to Mr. Dreher or the reappointment of Mr. Dreher.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: There is no correspondence between the McCracken County Judge Executive and Hendron District regarding the appointment of a commissioner for the term beginning April 1, 1999. Responsible witness: Don Peck.
