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

On September 27, 1999, West Shelby Water District ("West Shelby") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068. West Shelby's application was rejected pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 2(2), for its failure to include a copy of supplier's notice of the changed rate and the effective date as required by 807 KAR 5:068, Section 3; and for its failure to include information sufficient to determine the accurateness of the calculations of the purchased water adjustment as required by 807 KAR 5:068, Section 3(1).

On October 25, 1999, West Shelby submitted an amendment to its original application along with the other necessary information and its case was officially filed.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. West Shelby purchases water from three suppliers, Shelbyville Municipal Water ("Shelbyville"), North Shelby Water Company ("North Shelby"), and Louisville Water Company ("Louisville").

2. Shelbyville increased the wholesale water rate charged to West Shelby from \$1.15 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.37 per 1,000 gallons effective June 1, 1998. North Shelby increased the rates charged to West Shelby, effective March 12, 1999, as follows:

Louisville did not increase its rate to West Shelby.

- 3. During the 12 months ending July 31, 1999, West Shelby purchased a total of 208,022,300 gallons of water and sold 186,269,900 gallons.
- 4. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$27,159.52, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$0.15 per 1,000 gallons of water. Based on a monthly usage of 5,000 gallons, the average bill of a West Shelby customer would increase \$0.75 from \$22.42 to \$23.17 or 3.3 percent.
- 5. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.15 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.15 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A are approved for services rendered on and after October 25, 1999.
- 2. The revised tariff submitted by West Shelby is hereby rejected as filed because minimum bills for the 3/4 inch, 1 inch, 1 1/2 inch, 2 inch, and 3 inch meters are calculated incorrectly.

- 3. Within 20 days from the date of this Order, West Shelby shall file a copy of its revised tariff.
- 4. Within 20 days from the date of this Order, West Shelby shall file a copy of the notice to its customers and verification that such notice has been given.



The incremental cost to our customers is 15 cents per 1,000 gallons. We propose to raise each gallonage block that amount.

Dear Mr. LaCompto: WAMPA:

The Commission is in process of increasing both Water and Sewer Rates, effective with the June 1, 1998, billing date. This will affect usage for the Water Districts for the period of April 19 to May 19, 1998.

The general rate increase for water is necessary due primarily to the costs related to the proposed expansion of the Water Treatment Plant from 4.6 MGD to 6.0 MGD. In addition, funding is being requested for an estimated \$1.16 million dollars in Distribution system improvements. As you are well aware, operating costs have escalated over the last several years due to EPA requirements that have and will continue to impose more stringent requirements on water quality [with associated testing costs], and the spiraling labor costs and increased staffing requirements in the Water Treatment Industry.

Below is a history of rates to the Water Districts for the last several years:

Our consultant, Howard K. Bell, Consulting Engineers, has recently completed a Rate Study. {Copies of relevant portions are enclosed as Enclosure (1)}. A summary of the Consultant's calculations for the cost of water, with customer costs excluded, follows:

In the enclosed information, you will see that the Consultant has recommended rates to the Districts that range from \$1.51 to \$1.65/1,000 gallons, due to the contractual requirement with North Shelby stipulating that the rate to North Shelby shall not exceed the lowest rate of the Commission to its customers. increases recommended to the City Council.} As is obvious the rates to the Districts are lower than that required by the Cash Basis and the Utility Basis for Rate determination, due mainly due to the declining Rate Scale used by the Commission.
