### ORDER

On October 6, 1999, Alton Water and Sewer District ("Alton District") submitted an application for authority to increase the connection fee to its vacuum sewer system from \$2,000 to \$2,800. On November 2, 1999, the Commission's Executive Director advised Alton District by letter that its application failed to comply with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10, in certain respects. On November 18, 1999, Alton District responded to this letter, but failed to provide evidence of its compliance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(1)(b). On February 18, 2000, Alton District requested a deviation from the requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(1)(b).

Having considered the application and the request for deviation and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(1)(b), requires a utility to publish notice of an application for changes in non-recurring charges once a week for three consecutive weeks in a prominent manner in a newspaper of general circulation in its service area. It further requires that the first publication of notice be made prior to the filing of the utility's application.

- 2. Alton District published notice of the proposed change prior to submission of its application to the Commission and notified the Attorney General of the proposed increase to its connection charge.
- 3. Alton District failed to publish notice of the proposed change after submitting its application as Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(1)(b), requires.
- 4. Alton District is in the process of replacing its vacuum sewer system with a conventional gravity sewer system. Upon completion of this replacement, the charge in question will no longer be assessed.
- 5. The proposed adjustment will not affect customers currently receiving sewer service from Alton District.
  - 6. Good cause exists to grant the requested deviation.
- 7. Since the connection fee was last adjusted, substantial increases in the cost of materials and labor used to make a connection to Alton District's vacuum sewer system have occurred.
- 8. Alton District's average cost for making a connection to its vacuum sewer system is \$2,800.
- 9. The proposed charge is equal to the expense incurred to provide the associated service.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Alton District's request for a deviation from Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(1)(b), is granted.

2. Alton District's application shall be considered filed as of the date of this Order.

3. The proposed Residence Vacuum Sewer System Connection Fee of \$2,800 is approved for service rendered on and after the date of this Order.

4. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Alton District shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets that reflect the charges approved herein.

In regard to the above referenced case, we have been informed that we have a deficiency in the number of publications of the public notice. The notice was published one time on September 1, 1999, and the remaining two issues were inadvertently omitted from publication. Due to the fact that we have not received any comments as a result of the initial publishing, we respectfully request a deviation from this requirement. The application requests an increase in the nonrecurring charge of the connection fee to our vacuum sewer system. The Water District is in the process of replacing the vacuum system with a conventional gravity type system and eventually we anticipate there will be no need for this charge. The Water District has adopted the policy to prohibit any additional vacuum sewer extensions unless it is a new service located adjacent to a vacuum main where a gravity system is not presently feasible.






