The transfer of the Lawrence County Water District is complete. After the order was filed on March 2, 2000, the following procedures have taken place: March 15, 2000, the bank accounts were moved to Big Sandy Water District and used to pay outstanding debts, cost including past due operations and cost of transferring. The tap fee money of \$81,581.77 was paid to the engineer for his work on the Phase II Construction which we hope to advertise for bid next month. September 19, 2000, Lawrence County Fiscal Court transferred the operation territory to Big Sandy Water District (copy enclosed). September 26, 2000 a new bond was secured from Rural Utility Service for \$495,000 by Big Sandy Water District and paid off Lawrence County Water District Bond (copy enclosed).

The rates did not change for those customers previously served by Lawrence County Water District. The number has increased from 220 to 264.

Enclosed is the attorney's letter with copies of the assignment of intangible property and bill of sale of personal property we just received.

Aaron Greenwell's staff filed the 1999 Annual Report without Lafe Hinkle's 'signature. We are now working on our 2000 Audit and Annual Report trying to incorporate the assets and liablities to get a perfect financial picture.

I'm glad this is nearly over.

While in Louisa on Wednesday, I stopped into see Kim Compton to try yet again to have the executed documents returned that I had been working on since last September. She told me that she had given them to the County Judge Executive "last month" and I explained to her that those had to go to the Chairman of the Lawrence County Water District. She called Leif Hinkle and he confirmed that he had them and had had them in his file for over a month. I went over to the bank and picked them up and then went ahead and recorded the assignment of easements. I have enclosed copies of the assignment of intangible property and the absolute bill of sale for personal property.

We are making progress on the deeds, however, we were not able to find anything on the George W. Hardin estate. There is no recorded will in the County Clerk's office and there is no record of any probate in the District Clerk's office. # ORDER

Lawrence County Water District ("Lawrence District") and Big Sandy Water District ("Big Sandy District") (collectively "the Joint Applicants") have jointly applied for approval of the proposed transfer of Lawrence District's assets to Big Sandy District.

Having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- Lawrence District is a water district, organized pursuant to KRS Chapter 74, that provides water service to approximately 244 customers in Lawrence County, Kentucky.
- 2. As of December 31, 1998, Lawrence District had total net utility plant of \$1,629,543. 1
- 3. As of December 31, 1998, Lawrence District had total assets of \$1,715,669 and total liabilities of \$517,975.

- 4. For the 1998 calendar year, Lawrence District had operating revenues of \$43,581 and operating expenses of \$81,753. It had net losses of \$52,571.<sup>2</sup>
- 5. Rural Development ("RD"), an agency of the U.S. Department of Agriculture, currently holds \$495,000 in outstanding Lawrence District Revenue Bonds.
  - 6. Lawrence District acquires its water from the city of Louisa, Kentucky.
- 7. Big Sandy District has managed and operated Lawrence District's distribution system since June 1999.
- 8. Big Sandy District is a water district, organized pursuant to KRS Chapter 74, that provides water service to 2,502 customers in Boyd, Carter, and Lawrence counties, Kentucky.
  - 9. Big Sandy District has existed since 1977.
- 10. As of December 31, 1999, Big Sandy District had total net utility plant of \$5,129,060.<sup>3</sup>
- 11. As of December 31, 1999, Big Sandy District had total assets of \$5,894,344 and total liabilities of \$2,902,355.
- 12. For the 1999 calendar year, Big Sandy District had operating revenues of \$1,144,428 and operating expenses of \$961,843. It had net income of \$12,874.
- 13. As of December 31, 1999, Big Sandy District employed 11 persons to operate and manage its water distribution system. Six of these employees are certified

by the Kentucky Board of Certification of Water Treatment Plant and Water Distribution System Operators, as Class II-D distribution system operators.

- 14. Big Sandy District acquires its supply of water from the city of Louisa, Kentucky and Kenova Water Company.
- 15. On November 1, 1999, the Joint Applicants and RD executed a contract for the sale and transfer of Lawrence District's assets. Under the terms of this contract, Lawrence District will transfer all of its assets to Big Sandy District, and Big Sandy District will assume all obligations evidenced by Lawrence District's outstanding Revenue Bonds.
- 16. Big Sandy District's acquisition of Lawrence District's system will not immediately require the hiring of additional employees.
- 17. Big Sandy District will assess to customers currently located in Lawrence District's territory the same rates that Lawrence District currently assesses.
- 18. RD has approved the proposed transfer of assets to Big Sandy District. Prior to completion of the proposed transfer, Big Sandy intends to issue bonds in an amount equal to the outstanding Lawrence District Revenue Bonds to retire those bonds. The terms of these new bonds will be the same as those of the outstanding Lawrence District Revenue Bonds.
- 19. Prior to completion of the transfer, Big Sandy District will petition the Lawrence County Judge/Executive to expand its current boundaries to include all areas that Lawrence District presently serves and all areas in Lawrence County, Kentucky that are not presently served by Rattlesnake Ridge Water District, the city of Paintsville and the city of Louisa.

20. Big Sandy District has the financial, technical, and managerial abilities to provide reasonable utility service to those persons that Lawrence District currently serves.

- 21. The proposed transfer is consistent with the General Assembly's finding that the reduction of the number of operating water districts in Kentucky is in the public interest, will eliminate wasteful duplication of costs and efforts, result in a sounder and more businesslike degree of management, and ultimately result in greater economies, less cost, and a higher degree of service to the general public. See KRS 74.361(1).
- 22. The proposed transfer is in accordance with law, is for a proper purpose, and is consistent with the public interest.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed transfer of Lawrence District's assets is approved.
- 2. Within 10 days after the Lawrence County Judge/Executive expands Big Sandy District's boundaries pursuant to KRS 74.110, Big Sandy District shall file a copy of that Order with the Commission.
- 3. Within 20 days of completion of the transfer of Lawrence District's assets, Big Sandy District shall:
  - a. Notify the Commission in writing of the transfer's completion.
- b. File with the Commission revised tariff sheets reflecting the rates charged to customers previously served by Lawrence District.
- c. File the journal entries used to record the purchase and identify the detailed plant accounts to which the assets are recorded.

4. Lawrence District remains responsible for filing with the Commission the financial and statistical report required by Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:006, Section 3(1), for the 1998 and 1999 calendar years.

5. Nothing contained in this Order shall be construed as approval of Big Sandy District's issuance of evidences of indebtedness to RD to replace outstanding Lawrence District Revenue Bonds that RD currently holds.

# FINANCIAL EXAMINATION OF LAWRENCE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

#### **Introduction**

Lawrence County Water District ("Lawrence County") began operations in 1998 and serves approximately 230 residential and commercial customers in Lawrence County, Kentucky. The project under which the district's current system was constructed is referred to as Phase One. The district has collected tap-on fees for a second project referred to as Phase Two.

#### Scope

In May 1999 Lawrence County's chairman, Lafe Hinkle, contacted Financial Analysis Division Director, Aaron Greenwell, and requested a financial examination of the district. Mr. Hinkle stated that Lawrence County was considering a transfer of its system to Big Sandy Water District ("Big Sandy") and Big Sandy had requested information on its financial condition. Big Sandy began operating Lawrence County in May 1999. On June 14-16, 1999 Beverly Davis and Chris Whelan of the Commission's Financial Audit Branch went to Lawrence County's office in Louisa, Kentucky to begin the examination which covered the district's initial operations through May 31, 1999. The first activity for Phase One began in 1995; therefore, the years for which staff has compiled financial statements are the years ended December 31, 1995; 1996; 1997; 1998; and the period January 1, 1999 through May 31, 1999. These financial statements are attached as Appendices 1 - 5 to this report. These financial statements were compiled for regulatory reporting purposes for the use of the Public Service

Commission. The financial statements do not include a statement of cash flows or disclosures both of which are required by generally accepted accounting principles. In addition to the financial records, the examination consisted of reviewing compliance with the utility's tariff on file with the Commission and compliance with the uniform system of accounts and certain rules and regulations.

#### Accounting and Recordkeeping

The district's accounting records and procedures are subject to the requirements established by the Uniform System of Accounts for Class C Water Districts and Associations ("USoA"), as well as those prescribed by the Kentucky Public Service Commission. The district is new and does not have an established accounting and recordkeeping system. The records were not kept in an orderly fashion and related information was not kept together. In addition, the district did not file a 1998 annual report, its first year of operation. Staff recommends that the following recordkeeping practices be implemented by the district.

- 1. Plant Records. It is imperative that the costs of plant assets be effectively controlled and accurately accounted for because of the importance of these costs in determining rates. It is recommended that a subsidiary plant ledger be maintained with the accounting records to contain a card or sheet for each unit of property, showing details such as description, location, cost, vendor, date of purchase or installation, estimated salvage value, rate and method of depreciation, and depreciation accumulated to date.
- Invoices. The utility is advised to keep all invoices in an orderly fashion,
   either by vendor or month.

- 3. Customer Deposits. The district should maintain a card or sheet for each customer from whom a deposit is received indicating the name and address of the depositor, the service address, the date, and amount of deposit. Any interest paid or credited to the customer should be noted on the card/sheet. In addition, the date and amount of the refund of the deposit, if applicable, should be noted.
- 4. Interest on Customer Deposits. The district is reminded that interest must be paid on customer deposits in accordance with Kentucky Revised Statute 278.460 and Kentucky Administrative Regulation 5:006 Section 7 (6). The regulation provides that interest be paid on customer deposits annually and the statute states that "[n]o water district ...shall pay interest that exceeds the rate it receives in interest, nor shall the interest payable to the customer at any time exceed six percent..."
- 5. Cash. Lawrence County should keep a cash receipts and cash disbursements journal and perform monthly bank reconciliations for all bank accounts.

#### Laws and Rules - Deficiencies

The district's accounting records and procedures are subject to laws as provided by the Kentucky Revised Statutes, to rules as established by the Kentucky Administrative Regulations, and to the Federal Internal Revenue Code. The examination disclosed the following deviations from laws and rules:

Sales and School Tax. Lawrence County erroneously billed residential customers for sales tax from its initial billing (June 1998) through March 1999. In addition, no sales or school taxes collected were remitted to the proper authorities. Lawrence County is advised to refund to its residential customers the amount of sales

tax collected from each, to remit all commercial sales tax to the Revenue Cabinet, and to remit all school taxes collected to the Lawrence County School District.

#### Areas of Concern

- 1. Past Due Accounts Receivable. At May 31, 1999 Lawrence County's past due accounts receivable were equivalent to one-half of the monthly billing. This amount is excessive given the young age of the system. The utility is advised to adhere strictly to cut-off procedures. In addition, if the utility enters into payment agreements with customers and the customers violate the agreements, the utility should discontinue service to those customers until the entire past due amount is paid.
- 2. Line Loss. Line loss for 1999 through May was calculated at 37%. This is extremely high for a new system. In addition, the utility incurred significant repair expenses in 1998 that should not have been necessary for a new system. It should be noted that Bob McGlothlin, Superintendent of Big Sandy, advised staff that Lawrence County's line loss for July 1999 was between 15 and 20%. Lawrence County is advised to monitor its line loss closely and if line loss is excessive to consult Rural Development, the project engineers, and the project construction company to determine reasons for line loss and responsibility for making any necessary repairs.
- 3. Mileage Payments. As stated previously, Lawrence County paid mileage to one of its contractors. This payment was based on a hand-written invoice with a stated total number of miles. It is good management practice to require all expense reimbursement requests to be documented. Lawrence County is advised to require that anyone being paid mileage to keep a daily logbook and present this information when requesting reimbursement.

- 4. Insurance. The district carried an encroachment and treasurer bond as well as a commercial package that included liability, property, public official's liability, and equipment breakdown. However, all of the district's insurance expired in April 1999. Mr. McGlothlin informed staff that he has spoken with Lawrence County's insurance agent and has reduced the coverage of the treasurer bond and thus lowered the premium. He stated that the premium would be paid. He also stated that they were in the process of getting the encroachment bond released. Regarding the property insurance, Mr. McGlothlin has added Lawrence County's tank and pump station to Big Sandy's policy. As far as staff knows, Lawrence County has had no liability coverage since it expired in April 1999.
- 5. Number of Customers. Phase One had a projected customer number of 258; however, the July 1999 billing indicated approximately 230 customers. Mr. McGlothlin informed staff that there were approximately 40 taps appearing on the Lawrence County plans that were in the ground but were not yet receiving water. These taps could be dry for various reasons. For instance, some people may not have yet run the service line from the meter to the house; others may have paid for a water tap with no intention of hooking on unless their well went dry. If all 40 dry taps eventually begin receiving service, the district will have exceeded the customer projections. However, as of July 1999, the district had nearly 30 customers less than projected.

#### Conclusion

Lawrence County is advised to review this report carefully and respond to all numbered items in each section within 30 days of receipt of the final report. In addition, the utility shall file an annual report for 1998 within the same time period. Financial audit branch staff is available to discuss or assist in correcting any of the deficiencies noted.

#### JOINT APPLICATION

Pursuant to KRS 278.020(4) and 807 KAR 5:001§8, LAWRENCE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, a water district of Lawrence County, Kentucky ("LCWD") and BIG SANDY WATER DISTRICT, a water district of Boyd, Carter and Lawrence Counties, Kentucky ("BSWD"), hereby submit to the Public Service Commission of Kentucky ("Commission") their joint application for the transfer of ownership and control of LCWD's water system and assets to BSWD.

- 1. LCWD is a Water District, organized under and operating pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 74. It is a "utility", as defined in KRS 278.010(3)(d) and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to KRS 278.012. LCWD's territory covers portions of Lawrence County, Kentucky within which there are approximately 220 water service customers.
  - 2. LCWD's address is P.O. Box 250, Louisa, Kentucky 41230.
- 3. BSWD is a Water District, organized under and operating pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 74. It is a "utility", as defined in KRS 278.010(3)(d) and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to KRS 278.012. BSWD's territory covers portions of

Boyd, Carter and Lawrence Counties, Kentucky, within which there are approximately 2,491 water service customers.

- 4. BSWD's address is 18200 Kentucky Route 3, Catlettsburg, Kentucky 41129.
- 5. LCWD, through its Commission, desires to transfer ownership and control of all of its assets to BSWD. To that end, LCWD and BSWD have executed a Contract for Sale and Transfer ("Contract") filed herewith as **Exhibit "A"**. Pursuant to the Contract, LCWD will transfer all of its assets to BSWD in exchange for the assumption by BSWD of LCWD's outstanding indebtedness and other valuable consideration, including certain commitments of BSWD respecting water service in LCWD's territory.
- 4. BSWD has the financial, technical and managerial capability to serve the present customers of LCWD, and BSWD also has the capability to serve future customers in LCWD's territory. A Statement of the Superintendent of BSWD demonstrating its financial, technical and managerial capability and willingness to serve these customers is filed herewith as **Exhibit "B"**. (Big Sandy's 1999 Annual Report is incorporated herein by reference).
  - 5. Attached hereto is the Notice of Adoption, described in 807 KAR 5:011§11.

#### **CONTRACT FOR SALE AND TRANSFER**

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

THIS CONTRACT OF SALE AND TRANSFER (the "Contract"), made as of the 1st day of November, 1999, by and between LAWRENCE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ("LCWD"), a water district situated in Lawrence County, Kentucky, created and existing pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 74 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes (the "Act"); BIG SANDY WATER DISTRICT ("Big Sandy"), a water district situated in Boyd, Carter and Lawrence Counties, Kentucky, created and existing pursuant to the provisions of the Act; and UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, acting by and through the RURAL DEVELOPMENT ("RD"),

#### WITNESSETH

That in consideration of the mutual benefits flowing to each of the parties hereto, LCWD, Big Sandy and RD agree as follows:

#### ARTICLE I

#### **DEFINITIONS**

Section 101. In and throughout this Contract it will be appropriate and necessary to make repetitive reference to certain words, phrases and clauses, and in order to avoid repeating them at length it is deemed convenient and expedient to set forth certain definitions and shortened identifications thereof; and accordingly, wherever such defined or shortened references are utilized, the same shall have the following meanings unless a contrary intent shall clearly appear from the context, in which event the context shall be controlling:

"Act" refers to Chapters 74 and 273 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

"Area of Big Sandy" refers to the area in Boyd, Carter and Lawrence Counties, Kentucky, lying within the boundaries of Big Sandy as established in the proceedings pursuant to which Big Sandy was created and expanded in accordance with the Act.

"Area of LCWD" refers to the area in Lawrence County, Kentucky, lying within the boundaries of LCWD as established in the proceedings pursuant to which LCWD was created and expanded in accordance with the Act.

"Assumption Agreement" refers to the Assumption Agreement dated as of the Closing Date, by and among RD, LCWD and Big Sandy, wherein Big Sandy agrees to assume the Prior LCWD Bonds.

"Big Sandy" refers to Big Sandy Water District, a water district situated in Boyd, Carter and Lawrence Counties, Kentucky and created pursuant to the Act.

"Big Sandy Board" refers to the lawful and official governing body of Big Sandy.

"Big Sandy Chairperson" refers to the Chairperson of the Big Sandy Board.

"Big Sandy System" refers to the existing waterworks system of Big Sandy.

"Big Sandy's Water Rates" refers to the schedule of water service rates and charges presently promulgated, enforced and collected by Big Sandy, within the Area of Big Sandy, being the same schedule of rates and charges established by Order of the Public Service Commission, now in full force and effect, which rates and charges are attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.

"City" refers to the City of Louisa, Kentucky.

"Closing Date" refers to the date upon which the parties hereto shall consummate all of the actions to be performed by such parties as contemplated by this Contract.

"KRS" refers to the Kentucky Revised Statutes, as amended to the date of this Contract, and as the same may hereafter be amended from time to time.

"LCWD" refers to Lawrence County Water District, a water district situated in Lawrence County, Kentucky and created pursuant to the Act.

"LCWD Board" refers to the lawful and official governing body of LCWD.

"LCWD Chairperson" refers to the Chairperson of the LCWD Board.

"LCWD System" refers to the existing waterworks system of LCWD.

"LCWD's Water Rates" refers to the schedule of rates and charges for water service as presently promulgated, enforced and collected within the Area of LCWD, being the same schedule of rates and charges established by Order of the Public Service Commission, now in full force and effect, which rates and charges are attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

"Prior Big Sandy Bonds" refers to the outstanding bonds and obligations of Big Sandy as follows:

- (i) Big Sandy Water District Waterworks Revenue Bonds of 1989, dated March 6, 1991, in the original principal amount of \$640,000, currently held by RD;
- (ii) Kentucky Infrastructure Authority Loan, dated as of January 1, 1990, in the original principal amount of \$1,383,952; and
- (iii) Big Sandy Water District Waterworks Revenue Bonds of 1993, dated December 13, 1994, in the original principal amount of \$1,214,000, currently held by the RD.

"Prior LCWD Bonds" refers to the outstanding bonds designated as Lawrence County Water District Waterworks Revenue Bonds, Series 1997, dated September 18, 1997, in the original outstanding principal amount of \$500,000, currently held by RD.

"Public Service Commission" refers to the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, having jurisdiction over LCWD and Big Sandy pursuant to KRS Chapter 278.

"RD" refers to the Rural Development of the United States Department of Agriculture.

"Water Purchase Contract" refers to a written agreement made by LCWD and the City, whereby LCWD purchases water from the City for distribution to the customers of LCWD.

Section 102. The words "herein", "hereinbefore" and "hereinafter" are references to the text of this Contract.

#### **ARTICLE II**

#### **RECITALS AND REPRESENTATIONS**

Section 201. Recitals. The parties agree that the following is a true and accurate statement of certain history, facts and circumstances material to the making of this Contract, and is supplied in order to serve as a guide to the intentions of the parties, deemed to be useful in the understanding and interpretation of the provisions hereof, in the event such provisions are otherwise ambiguous in any way;

- A. Big Sandy is the owner of the works and facilities through which water service is provided to the citizens and inhabitants of the Area of Big Sandy. In that connection Big Sandy has outstanding, as of the date hereof, certain Prior Big Sandy Bonds, payable as to principal and interest solely from a pledge of and lien upon the revenues of the Big Sandy System.
- B. LCWD is the owner of the water distribution system constructed and installed by LCWD, and in that connection there are presently outstanding certain Prior LCWD Bonds which are currently held by RD.
- C. LCWD obtains its supply of water, for distribution to its customers from the City pursuant to the Water Purchase Contract, and has no independent water supply or facilities for the treatment and purification of water.
- D. As a temporary expedient, pending consummation of this Contract, Big Sandy presently maintains the LCWD System and also prepares bills and collects the revenues therefrom.

Section 202. Representations of LCWD. LCWD represents that it is a water district created and existing pursuant to the Act and as of date hereof is not in default in the payment of principal of or interest on the Prior LCWD Bonds, and has full lawful authority to carry out all of

the provisions of this Contract on its part to be performed and to enter into the Assumption Agreement with Big Sandy and RD.

Section 203. Representations of Big Sandy. Big Sandy represents that Big Sandy has outstanding no revenue bonds which are payable from water revenues, except the Prior Big Sandy Bonds; that as of the date hereof there is no default in the payment of principal of or interest on any of said Prior Big Sandy Bonds; and that it has the lawful right and power to enter into the Assumption Agreement with LCWD and RD, upon condition that it first obtain the written consent of the RD as holder of the Prior Big Sandy Bonds and the Prior LCWD Bonds.

Section 204. Representations of RD. RD represents that it is the holder of all of the Prior LCWD Bonds and that it will continue to hold same until the consummation of this Contract.

#### **ARTICLE III**

#### AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

The parties hereby agree, respectively, as follows:

#### Section 301. Agreements of LCWD. LCWD agrees that:

- (1) At or prior to the Closing Date it will execute and deliver to Big Sandy all such deeds, bills of sale and assignments as are deemed necessary by Counsel in order to vest in Big Sandy the complete ownership of all of the water distribution system and appurtenances heretofore acquired and presently owned by LCWD, together with its inventory of materials and supplies then on hand, and its accounts receivable (represented by service charges earned and uncollected as of the Closing Date, whether billed or unbilled).
- (2) Immediately after the execution of this Contract by all parties hereto, LCWD will join Big Sandy in instituting such proceedings as are required by law before the Public Service Commission, seeking approval of such transfer of title and ownership.
- (3) That it will deliver to Big Sandy, on the Closing Date, a true, complete and accurate list and statement of LCWD's current customers and LCWD's accounts payable as of the Closing Date.
- (4) On the Closing Date, LCWD will deliver to Big Sandy all sums as of the Closing Date accumulated and held in LCWD's Revenue Fund, Sinking Fund, Operation and Maintenance Reserve Fund and Depreciation Reserve Fund, which monies in such Funds of LCWD shall be deposited by Big Sandy in comparable Funds established in connection with the issuance of the Prior Big Sandy Bonds.

(5) On the Closing Date, LCWD will deliver to Big Sandy a true and accurate list of (i) its then issued and unpaid bills for water service then due or theretofore rendered, and (ii) its meter-readings as of the Closing Date, representing water service rendered but not yet billed in order that Big Sandy may effect collection thereof in an orderly manner.

#### Section 302. Agreements of Big Sandy. Big Sandy agrees:

- (1) That immediately after the execution of this Contract by all of the parties hereto, it will join LCWD in proper proceedings before the Public Service Commission, seeking such approving orders as are required by law insofar as LCWD is concerned.
- (2) Big Sandy will enter into the Assumption Agreement wherein Big Sandy will assume the obligations evidenced by the Prior LCWD Bonds.
- (3) That it will receive from LCWD, such monies as LCWD shall transfer to Big Sandy from LCWD's Revenue Fund, Sinking Fund, Operation and Maintenance Reserve Fund and Depreciation Reserve Fund, and will deposit such sums in corresponding funds established in connection with the Prior Big Sandy Bonds.
- (4) That it will pay, from money collected by Big Sandy for water service rendered in the Area of LCWD, such accounts payable of LCWD as LCWD makes known to Big Sandy at the Closing Date.
- (5) That from and after the Closing Date Big Sandy will render water service directly to the present customers of LCWD, and to such customers within the Area of LCWD as may hereafter be interconnected with the water facilities upon compliance with the rules and regulations of Big Sandy, as the same may prevail from time to time; that Big Sandy will furnish such water service at LCWD's Rates (Exhibit A); and will continue to furnish such water service at LCWD's Rates until

such time as Big Sandy desires to change such LCWD's Rates by proper legal proceedings before the Public Service Commission.

Section 303. Agreements of RD. RD agrees that on or before the Closing Date it will enter into the Assumption Agreement with LCWD and Big Sandy.

Section 304. Water Purchase Contract Will Be Assumed. Big Sandy and LCWD agree that on or before the Closing Date and upon consummation of this Contract in all of its aspects, the Water Purchase Contract will be assigned to Big Sandy.

Section 305. If Material Litigation Is Pending At The Closing Date. LCWD, Big Sandy and RD are in mutual agreement that this Contract will not be consummated if, upon the Closing Date, there is litigation pending in any court of competent jurisdiction (or known by any of the parties to be threatened) challenging the legality of material actions proposed to be taken by the parties as herein provided. In the event such litigation has been filed or is known to be imminently threatened, the parties may (a) by mutual agreement postpone the Closing Date for a reasonable period of time, or (b) any party may cancel this Contract upon notice to the other parties. In the event of cancellation, the parties will remain in the same status as if this Contract had not been executed, without liability of any party to any other party; and each party shall absorb and pay any expense which it has incurred up to that time.

#### ARTICLE IV

#### **EXECUTION AND RECITATION OF AUTHORITY**

Section 401. LCWD has caused this Contract to be executed in its name and on its behalf by the LCWD Chairperson, and has caused its seal to be affixed, attested by the Secretary of its Board, and represents that due authority has been vested in such officers by a Resolution of the Board of LCWD, now in full force and effect.

Section 402. Big Sandy has caused this Contract to be executed in its name and on its behalf by the Big Sandy Chairperson and its seal to be affixed, attested by the Secretary of its Board, all being done pursuant to a Resolution duly adopted by the Big Sandy Board and now in full force and effect.

Section 403. RD has caused this Contract to be executed by its State Director and represents that said State Director is vested with full authority in law to execute the same.

<u>Section 404.</u> This Contract may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original, for all purposes.

Section 405. This Contract is made as of the year and day first above written, and shall be effective as of that date without regard to the fact that execution hereof by the parties shall have been effected at the same time or at other times.

Annual Report is incorporated herein by reference and sets forth factual information to show that Big Sandy has the financial, technical and managerial ability to serve Lawrence County's customers.
