MOTION OF KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY AND
LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY TO
MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (collectively, the “Companies”) hereby move the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to modify the procedural schedule in this case by extending the time the Companies have to file their additional supplemental rebuttal testimony from March 28, 2005, to March 30, 2005, by the close of business that day, and by adding two days to the remaining items on the current procedural schedule. In support of this Motion, the Companies state as follows:

By Order dated March 10, 2005, the Commission established the current procedural schedule in this proceeding. The schedule requires the Companies to file their additional supplemental rebuttal testimony by next Monday, March 28, 2005. The Companies respectfully request an additional two days to file their Additional Supplemental Rebuttal Testimony due to the significant amount of data the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (“MISO”) provided this week in response to the Companies’ data requests, and the time it is taking to fully analyze the information and prepare the testimony. The Companies further respectfully request that the remaining dates on the current procedural schedule be extended by

two days as well to avoid any prejudice to the other parties. The amendments to the procedural schedule are set forth below:

LG&E and KU shall file any additional supplemental rebuttal testimony in verified prepared form no later than:	03/30/05
All data requests to LG&E and KU on their additional supplemental rebuttal testimony shall be filed no later than:	04/06/05
LG&E and KU shall respond to data requests on their additional supplemental rebuttal testimony no later than:	04/13/05

WHEREFORE, the Companies move the Commission to enter an order modifying the current procedural schedule in this case to allow the Companies as set forth above.
