MOTION OF KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY AND LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR LEAVE TO FILE ADDITIONAL TESTIMONY

Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (collectively, the "Companies") hereby move the Public Service Commission ("Commission") to grant all the parties leave to file simultaneous, additional testimony in this proceeding on or before July 7, 2005, limited solely to issues concerning the actual operations of the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc.'s ("MISO") wholesale generation markets (the "Day 2 Markets") under its Transmission and Energy Markets Tariff ("TEMT"). On April 1, 2005, MISO began operating the Day 2 Markets and continues to do so. The Companies believe that the filing by all parties of additional testimony concerning their experiences with the operation of the Day 2 Markets under the MISO TEMT will create a more current record for the Commission, thereby better informing the Commission's ultimate decision in this case. Furthermore, the Companies and MISO have agreed that July 7, 2005, is a workable date for filing their testimony; moreover, all parties and the Commission Staff were included in an e-mail exchange on this topic, and none objected to allowing the filing of additional testimony, nor did any party object to the July 7, 2005, date for filing.

The Companies further request that the Commission not delay the hearing scheduled for July 20, 2005, due to the making or the granting of this motion, because of the critical need for final resolution of this proceeding in a timely fashion.

WHEREFORE, the Companies move the Commission to enter an order granting the parties leave to file additional testimony solely concerning the Companies' operations in the MISO Day 2 markets and the financial impacts thereof by July 7, 2005.
