- Please provide total amounts of funds contributed by customers to the WinterCare program on an annualized basis for the past five years and the total amount of funds KU matched for individual donations to the WinterCare program on an annualized basis for the past five years.
- 3. Please describe in detailed narrative form all initiatives developed and implemented by KU to assist low-income customers in making their energy costs more affordable.
- 4. For each of the initiatives identified in your response to question 3, please provide all costs associated with the development and implementation of such initiative on an annualized basis for the past five years.

- 5. Please provide a complete list of all grants issued by the LG&E Energy Foundation over the past five years which were intended to assist low-income customers with their home energy bills, including name of recipient, the amount of each grant, a narrative describing the intended impact of the grant on low-income households and specify which grants were intended to assist the KU customers and which were intended to assist the LG&E customers.
- 6. Does KU intend to continue matching the funding of the WinterCare program at the conclusion of this case and decisions rendered by the Commission, and if your answer is yes, please indicate the level of match that is intended?
- 7. What impact has the implementation of House Bill 305 (low income energy assistance bill passed by the 2002 Kentucky Legislature) had at KU in regards to future programming designed to help the low-income customers?
- 8. Does KU intend to continue funding the WeCare program at the conclusion of this case and decisions rendered by the Commission and if your answer is yes, please indicate the level of funding that is intended?
