I received today your letter of January 27, 2004. To assist you in fixing the proposed location of the tower I am enclosing a copy of a plat that will be filed later this week along with the application. As shown on the plat, the tower will be located on property owned by Whayne Supply Company and across U.S. 60 from your property. From the plat, it appears the southwestern (closest) boundary of your property is located approximately 2,000 feet from the tower.



I will withdraw my request if I  
can determine that the tower will be  
so located as to not be detrimental  
to my property. I hereby request that  
you assist me in determining (under-  
standing, visualizing) where the tower  
actually will be situated. I do not  
comprehend the coordinates specified  
by latitude and longitude. Please  
provide me an explanation in  
"layman's terms." A map/diagram would help.  
Specifically, I need to know  
where the tower is situated relative  
to US HIGHWAY 60, WEST. Will it  
be on the same side of that highway  
as Wayne Supply and Fairfield

Inn and Arby's?

I do not understand "behind the Wayne Supply Company," Please explain "behind" as that pertains to US 60 (and perhaps Paul Coffey Industrial Park).

It would also be helpful if I knew the name of the owner/s on whose property the tower will be placed. If I knew that information, I quite likely would know the location.

However, at the present time, I do indeed request intervention and will withdraw that request only if I determine upon further clarification and receipt of information requested that my property will not be devalued.

ALLTEL Communications, Inc. is applying to the Public Service Commission of Kentucky for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a new facility to provide cellular telecommunications service in along U.S. Route 60 and State Route 180 in north central Boyd County. The facility will consist of a self-supporting 199 foot three-sided metal tower and adjacent equipment shelter. The tower will be located behind the Whayne Supply Company, 12251 U.S. Route 60, Ashland, Kentucky and located at N 38°23'44.83" Latitude and W 82°42'58.52" Longitude.

This notice is being sent to you because you own property within 500 feet of the proposed site of the tower or own property that abuts the Whayne Supply property. The Commission invites your comments concerning the proposed construction. You also have the right to seek intervention in the proceeding.
