## JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

NewSouth Communications Corp., NuVox Communications, Inc., and Xspedius Communications, LLC, on behalf of its operating subsidiaries Xspedius Management Co. Switched Services LLC, Xspedius Management Co. of Lexington, LLC and Xspedius Management Co. of Louisville, LLC (collectively the "Joint Petitioners"), and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), jointly move the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the "Commission") to extend the deadline for filing the interconnection agreement in the above-referenced case from October 26, 2005 until 30 days after the Commission rules on the pending petitions for reconsideration. In support of their motion, the parties state as follows.

On September 26, 2005 the Commission issued an order in the above-referenced case regarding the outstanding issues in the arbitration. The order required the parties to file their interconnection agreement no later than October 26, 2005. The Joint Petitioners filed a petition for reconsideration on October 17, 2005, and BellSouth filed a petition for reconsideration on

October 18, 2005. Pursuant to KRS 278.400, the Commission has twenty days to act on the petitions. Thus, the Commission has until November 7, 2005 to decide both parties' petitions.<sup>1</sup>

The content of the interconnection agreement is dependent in part on the Commission's resolution of the arbitrated issues. That resolution is not yet final given the pending petitions for reconsideration. Accordingly, it is not in the interest of administrative economy for the parties to file, and the Commission to review, the interconnection agreement until after the Commission has ruled on the parties' petitions for reconsideration. Therefore, the Joint Petitioners and BellSouth respectfully request that the Commission extend the deadline for filing the interconnection agreement until 30 days after the Commission rules on the parties' petitions for reconsideration. By filing this motion for extension neither party waives the right to seek additional time to file a compliant agreement to take into account the Commission's rulings in the Generic Proceeding for those issues previously in the arbitration relating to the TRRO that the Commission moved to the Generic Proceeding for consideration and resolution.
