Question No. 1

Provide the average annual gas consumption for customers who:

- a. Use natural gas as a primary source of heat.
- b. Do not use natural gas as a primary source of heat.

Response of Columbia Gas of Kentucky:

- a. The average annual gas consumption for heating is 70 MCF per year.
- b. Customers who do not use natural gas as the primary source for heating, may use natural gas for water heating which averages 30 MCF per year or gas logs which average 12 MCF per year. The use of natural gas for cooking averages 4 MCF per year and grilling averages 2 MCF per year.

Question No. 2

Under what conditions would a customer who does not use natural gas as a primary source of heat be required to pay only a portion of the annual average installation costs?

Response of Columbia Gas of Kentucky:

A customer who does not use natural gas as the primary source of heat, would pay only one-half of the annual average installation costs if the customer used natural gas for water heating. Columbia advised the complainant of this option in December 2003.
