Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure its legibility.

- 3. Other payments during 2003 included \$989.00 to "Agr. Fab," \$271.20 to "Seay Oil," and \$300.00 for a "Ky. State Permit Ap." Describe the nature of each payment and state whether each will recur on an annual basis.
- 4. W&W lists payments in the "Utility" category under "Gas Charges." For each payment, state the type of "gas" (gasoline or natural gas) purchased and explain how the purchase related to the provision of sewer service.

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- 5. W&W made several payments to Lowes and Home Depot during 2003. Provide all detailed receipts or other supporting documentation from these vendors showing the materials purchased on behalf of the utility.
- The application filed by W&W includes several proposed adjustments for 6. estimated expenditures to be made subsequent to 2003. For each of the proposed expenditure, state whether it has been made, provide supporting invoices or other documentation, and state whether the expenditure will recur on an annual basis.
- 7. State whether the Kentucky Secretary of State administratively dissolved W&W in 1998.
- Describe the actions that W&W has taken to become a corporation b. in good standing in Kentucky.
- Provide verification from the Kentucky Secretary of State that W&W C. is a corporation in good standing in the state of Kentucky.


