This is in regard to a NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT ("Notice to Adopt") the Interconnection Agreement between BellSouth and Time Warner filed by US LEC of Tennessee, Inc. ("US LEC"), on March 8, 2004. US LEC also has filed a PETITION FOR ARBITRATION OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, A PETITION TO RESOLVE DISPUTE PURSUANT TO TERMS OF THE PARTIES' INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT on March 16, 2004.

With regard to the Notice of Intent to Adopt the currently effective interconnection agreement, it is my understanding that US LEC and BellSouth have reached agreement and that US LEC will be filing a Motion to Consolidate the two proceedings into the Petition for Arbitration or will be dismissing, without prejudice, the Notice to Adopt. Accordingly, BellSouth will not be filing a Response to US LEC's Notice to Adopt.
