
Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

After receiving a copy of LG&E's July 6, 2004 response to you, from John Wolfram, I wanted to correct a point. With regard to K.U.'s point in question number one, that the outage occurred on Nov. 29, 2001, not my estimate of 2002, I stand corrected. I should have checked my records before estimating the date.

With regard to K.U.'s second point in the first question, my estimate of the date of the installation must be also be wrong because I am certain that K.U. lineman Kenneth Laffoon and Mr. Brinkley were the two linemen who repaired my service and installed the connector to correct the swag in the line. I have known Mr. Laffoon for many years, he worked for my father many years ago. I am also familiar with Mr. Brinkley. These are definitely the two men who did shorten my neutral wire that night to correct the swag, while repairing the service that had been torn off the wall and was laying in the yard. I am certain of this fact.

If my incorrect estimate of the date of this splice has caused K.U. to respond with a lack of records, I will start all over and repeat my complaint if necessary, but since I stated Laffoon and Brinkley installed the splice, it would seem that K.U. should have known to look at the records of the dates before they said Laffoon retired in 1998.
