Adoption by Southern Digital Network, Inc. d/b/a FDN Communications of the Interconnection Agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. PSC Case No. 2004-00244

Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

Southern Digital Network, Inc., d/b/a FDN Communications ("FDN"), and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., ("BellSouth"), advise the Kentucky Public Service Commission that the issues addressed in the above-referenced docket have been resolved. The parties have entered into a settlement agreement such that FDN and BellSouth have entered into an interconnection agreement that incorporates language that is compliant with the Triennial Review Order (TRO), and the parties are currently negotiating language to comply with the post- DC Circuit Order's vacatur of certain portions of the TRO1. These negotiations began as of July 15, 2004, and shall last no longer than a period of forty-five (45) calendar days. After that time period, should there be any outstanding issues remaining between the parties as to the interpretation of the DC Order<sup>2</sup> or the TRO, the parties do not waive any rights available to petition the Commission for resolution of such issues. By entering into this settlement agreement, the parties are agreeing to shorten the change of law period to forty-five (45) calendar

days, and the parties agree that the change of law negotiations will be specifically related to incorporating the D.C. Order for FDN Agreements in all nine BellSouth states.
