The Union Light, Heat and Power Company (ULH&P) respectfully requests that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (Commission) schedule an informal conference in this proceeding. In support of this request, ULH&P respectfully states:

- On June 18, 2004, ULH&P filed an Application for approval of certain economic development tariffs.
- 2. On July 21, 2004, the Commission established a procedural schedule in this case, providing for the parties to submit data requests to ULH&P.
- 3. On July 27, the Commission's Staff and the Kentucky Attorney General (AG) submitted data requests to ULH&P. ULH&P provided responses to these data requests on August 6th and 9th, respectively, noting that it would have to supplement three responses to the AG's data requests.
