
**MOTION FOR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Northern Kentucky Water District, by counsel, moves for an order establishing a procedural schedule. The District would like to resolve this matter as quickly as possible and requests that a schedule for discovery and a hearing, if necessary, be set.

The District also moves that the Commission request the participation of the Kentucky Division of Water in this case. Because the Division of Water's regulation is a crucial issue in this case and acceptance by the Division of Water of any cross connection policy implemented by the District is necessary, its participation is essential to fully resolve any issues that might arise. As such, the Division of Water is an indispensable party to the proceeding. In Case No. 2003-000057, Order of May 13, 2003, the Commission found that "because of the potential effect that the issues in this proceeding may have, and to protect KU's interests, KU is an indispensable party to this proceeding and should be included." The same can be said of the Division of Water's interests in this matter.

For these reasons, Northern Kentucky Water District requests that a procedural schedule be established and that the Division of Water be named an indispensable party to the proceeding.


