2. Applicant is engaged in the business of supplying electric service in and to various cities and the inhabitants thereof within the State of Kentucky and has conducted such business for a number of years. Applicant is and for many years has provided electric service in the city of Bremen, Kentucky. Now Bremen has requested that KU bid for the franchise service right for said city. This Application will allow KU the opportunity to bid for this new franchise and allow KU to erect along, over, under or across the public ways and grounds thereof Applicant's electric utility facilities used by Applicant in its supply of electric service in and to the City and the inhabitants thereof.

3. Applicant owns sources of supply of electric energy now being furnished to customers in said City, and has distribution

facilities in said City, now used in furnishing electric service in said City.

4. Applicant has heretofore filed with the Commission a copy of its amended and restated Articles of Incorporation in Case No. 2003-00434.

5. There is and will continue to be a demand and need for electric service in and to such City and the inhabitants thereof; and Applicant desires to apply for and obtain from such City a franchise.

6. Should Applicant be successful in acquiring said franchise, it will file copies thereof with the Commission.

WHEREFORE, Applicant asks that the Commission enter an Order, granting to Applicant a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to bid for and acquire the described franchise from the City identified in paragraph 2 above.
