HEARING CAMPBELL COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Campbell County Board of Education will hold a public hearing at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 28, 2004, at the Central Office, 101 Orchard Lane, Alexandria, Kentucky, for the purpose of hearing public comments regarding proposed 2004-05 general fund tax levies on real estate of 50.9 cents per \$100 of property valuation and on personal property of 52.2 cents per \$100 of property valuation.

In fiscal year 2003-04 the general fund tax rate levied on real estate was 49.7 cents and on personal property was 52.1 cents and produced total revenue of \$10,746,884, compared to that year's expected total of \$11,223,069 assuming a 100% collection rate. For 2004-05 the proposed general tax rates of 50.9 cents on real estate and 52.2 cents on personal property are expected to produce revenue of \$11,825,306 (assuming a 100% collection rate) of which \$253,286 is expected to be from new property and \$1,025,640 is expected to be from personal property. Of the total expected tax revenue for 2004-05, \$11,323,569 is projected to be collected as current year's taxes paid to the Campbell County Sheriff, based on the prior year's collection rate.

The 2004-05 compensating general tax rate is 49.0 cents on real estate and 52.2 cents on personal property with total revenue expected to be \$11,422,175 if this rate were used and if there were a 100% collection rate.

The general areas to which 2004-05 revenues in excess of 2003-04 revenues will be allocated are as follows: Building Fund, Cost of Collection, and Instruction. The General Assembly has required publication of this advertisement and information contained herein.
