



SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE

Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation (“JPEC”) filed its Response to First Data Request of Commission Staff on July 20, 2005. Subsequent to that filing JPEC has filed an Amended Application in which proposed CATV rates are based on adherence to the Case No. 251 uniform methodology, including the use of the rate of return in JPEC’s last general rate case that had a rate of return stipulated in its order. JPEC is using the following components in the rate calculations in its Amended Application, to-wit:

Rate of Return (Case No. 8863) – 8.88%
Appurtenance Adjustment Factor – 85%
Per Ground Value -- \$12.50

In light of the Amended Application filing, JPEC’s original Response to First Data Request of Commission Staff is hereby modified as follows:

Introduction - In the calculation of proposed rates JPEC is not changing the percentage adjustment for minor appurtenances or the amount per ground, but is using the factors set forth in the final order in Case No. 251.

Item 1 – The information in the original Response is correct but is now irrelevant.

Item 4 – The second paragraph of the original Response is deleted.

Item 5 – While the information in the original Response is correct, it is irrelevant because JPEC is now using the net value of its entire utility plant in calculating the rate of return.

Item 6 – JPEC is now using the rate of return in its last general rate case in which the order stipulated a rate of return, which is 8.88% from Case No. 8863. Therefore the depreciation rates that resulted from the Commission’s Order in 2002-00485 are now irrelevant.
