Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(8), Beech Fork Processing, Inc. ("Beech Fork") submits this motion for full intervention in the above-captioned proceeding.

Beech Fork is a Kentucky corporation which conducts a coal mining operation in Johnson County, Kentucky. Beech Fork's property adjoins the property where BellSouth Mobility, LLC ("BellSouth") proposes to construct a wireless communications facility (the "WCF" and the property upon which it proposes to construct a WCF, the "WCF Property"). It also owns or leases the coal reserves located under the WCF Property and holds a permit to mine such reserves by an underground mine.

Beech Fork objects to the placement of the WCF on the WCF Property. Among other things, Beech Fork believes that the WCF would create a danger to its mining operations. Beech Fork believes that more suitable sites for the WCF exist in the area.

Beech Fork's interest is not otherwise adequately represented. Beech Forks' participation is likely to present issues or to develop facts that will assist the Commission without unduly complicating the proceeding.
