## Dear Director:

This letter is to make an official protest on behalf of CONSOL of Kentucky Inc., ("CKI") regarding the issuance of a permit to Bell South Mobility, LLC, d/b/a Cingular Wireless to construct a mobile telephone tower on property which we are currently permitting to mine. The reason for our Protest is that CONSOL of Kentucky has owned the coal beneath this surface in question for many years and are presently in the process of permitting and preparing to mine our coal. CONSOL's proposed mine plan is show on the map attached. The construction, at this time, of a telephone tower upon the surface which we have the right to mine is counter-productive and a hazard to the public.

As you are aware the mineral estate in Kentucky is the dominant estate and CONSOL has a legal right to exercise its rights to remove its mineral.

We respectfully request and strongly encourage the Commission to deny or rescind any permit granted for a surface use until our mining operations are completed and or CKI has reached an agreement with Cingular Wireless regarding our coal that would be impacted by this tower.


