APPLICATION

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), pursuant to KRS 278.018(6) and 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8, hereby applies for approval of changes in certified service territory as agreed with Owen County Electric Cooperative ("Owen Electric").

1. Address: The Applicant's full name and post office address is Kentucky Utilities Company, One Quality Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40507.
2. Articles of Incorporation: A certified copy of Kentucky Utilities Company's (KU's) Restated Articles of Incorporation is on file with the Commission in Case No. **2003-00434**.
3. Statement of Business: KU is a public utility engaged in the business of generating, transmitting, and distributing electric service.
4. Description of Changes in Service Territory: KU and Owen Electric have individually agreed to the requested territorial change.

The territorial boundary change requested for the Spenlau Property (campground) in Sanders, Kentucky is a re-alignment with property lines. This requested change will serve the purposes of KRS 278.016 by avoiding unnecessary encumbering of the landscape, allowing the electric service for the good of public convenience and necessity and promoting the orderly development of retail electric service. The territorial maps provided constitute the entire agreement between KU and Owen Electric.

Included is a summary list of the requested territorial changes identifying KU personnel familiar with the specifics of the facilities available, the reason for the change, and purposes served


under KRS 278.016.

WHEREFORE, KU hereby requests, pursuant to KRS 278.018, that the Commission enter its order approving the service territory changes and Agreements allocating these electric consumers as agreed to by the parties. Due to the bulk of the maps, KU requests the Commission to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8 (2) and permit KU to file only two complete sets of maps.


