MOTION FOR NUNC PRO TUNC AMENDMENT TO **COMMISSION'S ORDER OF NOVEMBER 1, 2005**

Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") and Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") (collectively, the "Companies") hereby move this Commission to amend its November 1, 2005 Order in this matter to include a finding regarding the Site Compatibility Certificate requested by the Companies in this proceeding. In support of this motion, the Companies state as follows:

In addition to the certificate of public convenience and necessity and approval for land sale sought in this proceeding, the Companies also requested a Site Compatibility Certificate from the Commission pursuant to KRS 278.216.1 The Companies submitted a Site Assessment Report as part of their Joint Application.² As the Companies' witness Sharon L. Dodson explained, that Report "demonstrates that the Companies' plans for TC2 satisfy the requirements for the Site Compatibility Certificate" because the "addition of a second coal-fired generating unit at the Trimble Station will not cause a negative impact to local property values, unduly

increase traffic or noise, nor change the visual impacts of the facility from current conditions."³ Those findings were reviewed and confirmed by BBC Research & Consulting, on behalf of Commission Staff, in the written report filed of record in this proceeding.⁴ Specifically, BBC concluded that, "[g]iven the existing plant, TC2 is compatible with its scenic surroundings."⁵ Neither the Attorney General nor any of the other intervenors in any way challenged the findings of the Site Assessment Report, or contested the Companies' request for a Site Compatibility Certificate.

In its Order of November 1, 2005, the Commission did not address the issue of a Site Compatibility Certificate. In light of the above evidence, it appears that the lack of reference to the Site Compatibility Certificate in the Commission's November 1, 2005 Order was inadvertent, and that a ruling on the requested Certificate could be addressed by an amendment to the November 1 Order.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission enter an order amending its November 1, 2005 Order, *nunc pro tunc*, to include a finding that the Companies established that a Site Compatibility Certificate should be awarded, and to include an ordering paragraph granting KU and LG&E each a Site Compatibility Certificate for their respective ownership interests (81% and 19%, respectively) in the Companies' collective 75% share of TC2 as proposed in this proceeding.
