Dear Mr. Sallee:

I am writing in response to your letter to the Public Service Commission requesting information regarding the application by Nextel WIP Lease Corp. for approval to construct a wireless tower facility in Greenville, Muhlenburg County, Kentucky. We will respond to your questions in the order received.

1. How wide (or how much space) would be involved?

**Answer:** The ground lease involved is 350' x 400'.

2. When will the work for the tower be started?

**Answer:** The work will commence immediately upon PSC approval.

3. Do you pay for the right, and if so, approximately how much?

**Answer:** Hemphill pays for the right to lease ground space and do not feel the amount being paid is relative to Mr. Sallee.

4. Do I have the right to prevent this? If for some reason I should be in a position?

**Answer:** You have the right to intervene through the Public Service Commission.

5. How long would this tower be there?


**Answer:** Assuming Hemphill receives PSC approval, we have a five-year lease with options to automatically renew the lease for nine additional five-year terms. Therefore, the tower will remain for at least fifty years.

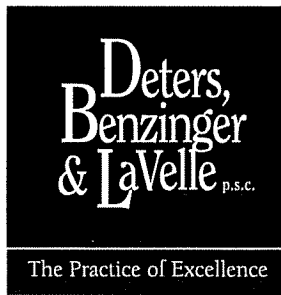

1. How will this 340' foot guyed tower location, within 500 feet of my home?



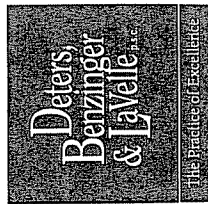

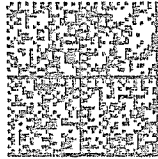
