



Dear Ms. Maslin:

I am responding to your letter regarding the filings with the Kentucky Public Service Commission and the Association's request for increases in the miscellaneous fees.

The regulatory provision in 807 KAR 5:011 Section 10 (2) requires the District to file, in addition to other filings an "absorption test" if the additional revenue to be generated from the increases is greater than five (5) percent the total revenues provided by all miscellaneous and recurring charges for a twelve month period. The absorption test is to show the additional revenues from the increase will not result in a rate of return greater than the level of the latest rate case.

We have recently completed our audit of the Association for the year ended December 31, 2004. The financial statements of the Association report the actual revenue generated for the calendar year ended December 31, 2004 from recreation fees as \$7,940. This consists of \$7,700 (308 @ \$25 each) in recreation fees and \$240 (24 @ \$10 each) from field collection charges.

The estimated revenue using the proposed rates would be as follows:

Subscription fees	308 @ \$25	\$15,400
Field collection charges	24 @ \$10	648
Total estimated revenue		\$16,000

The Association estimates the cost of these services


Reconnections \$50 each	\$15,400
Field collection charges \$27 each	648
Total estimated costs	\$16,048

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Based upon this analysis the Association, the propose rates will not cover the cost of the service, and therefore will not increase the rate of return.
