The Commission entered the enclosed Final Order in this case on March 10, 2005. It was ordered that "NKWD shall furnish documentation of the total costs of this project including the cost of construction and all other capitalized costs (engineering, legal, administrative, etc.) within 60 days of the date that construction is substantially completed.
