MOTION OF EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE, INC., FOR AN ENLARGEMEMENT OF TIME IN WHICH TO FILE RESPONSES TO INFORMATION REQUESTS FROM THE HEARING HELD ON NOVEMBER 29, 2005

East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc., ("EKPC") hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for an enlargement of time in which to respond to information requests made by the Commission staff at the hearing in this case, held on November 29, 2005. As grounds for this Motion, EKPC states as follows:

1. At the subject hearing, the Commission staff requested that EKPC submit an economic analysis concerning the timing of the commercial operation of proposed new combustion turbines at the Smith Station site, in light of the current schedule for the installation of new transmission capacity to support new generation at that site. EKPC is in the process of obtaining and evaluating information which is relevant to this analysis, and preliminary discussions between EKPC transmission and generation planning staff have taken place. These discussions have explored alternative transmission projects which could alleviate the timing concerns which were discussed at the hearing. Further

discussions of such measures will require additional meetings, which cannot take place until the week of December 12, 2005, due to pre-existing commitments of the EKPC staff involved. This will leave insufficient time to incorporate information regarding such alternative measures into the requested economic evaluation, and adequately review the evaluation before the scheduled filing date of December 13.

2. The response to a portion of the other information request at that hearing, made by the Chairman, regarding a schedule of the historic operation of EKPC's combustion turbines at the Smith Station site, has been filed along with this motion. The remainder of the response, regarding projected future use of both existing and proposed new combustion turbines, cannot be completed until the evaluation of alternative transmission measures, discussed above, is complete. Therefore, EKPC proposes to submit this information at the time that the economic analysis is filed.

WHEREFORE, EKPC respectfully moves the Commission for an enlargement of time through December 22, 2005, in which to respond to the subject information requests.
