#### INTRA-AGENCY MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: February 14, 2006 - Informal Conference

Pursuant to the Commission's Order of February 2, 2006, an informal conference was held in this case on February 14, 2006. A copy of the conference attendance list is appended hereto as Appendix A.

Beginning the conference, Anita Mitchell of Commission Staff ("Staff") explained that a memorandum of the conference would be prepared for the case record and that a copy of the memorandum would be provided to counsel for review and comment.

Ms. Mitchell directed the participants' attention to the Commission's Order which stated that the informal conference was scheduled for the purpose of developing a procedural schedule that would permit the Attorney General ("AG") the opportunity to conduct discovery and to develop testimony and evidence to meet his burden of proof. Staff distributed a proposed procedural schedule, appended hereto as Appendix B, that was designed to allow the AG the opportunity discussed in the Commission's Order and to process the case before the next heating season.

Dennis Howard of the AG's office stated that while the AG would like to process this case as quickly as possible, he did not believe that Staff's proposed procedural schedule would allow the parties sufficient time to process the case. He explained that he thought the processing of the case would be similar to that of the Commission's investigation into the earnings of Brandenburg Telephone Company,<sup>1</sup> which he stated was processed in approximately 20 months. While he stated he was not proposing that this case take 20 months, he stated that this case would take some time to process. Mir. Howard acknowledged the AG's burden of proof and stated that time would be required for him to work with his experts and to draft the necessary information requests to Atmos Energy Corporation ("Atmos"). He stated that he thought the information he would seek from Atmos would be the equivalent of what Atmos would be required to file if it was seeking a rate adjustment and that as a result, Atmos

would need at least 60 days to compile the necessary information. He stated that he had also drafted a proposed procedural, which is appended hereto as Appendix C. After Staff made copies, the AG's proposed procedural schedule was distributed to the participants for review and discussion.

After inquiry from Commission Staff, Atmos stated that it had contemplated filing an application for a rate adjustment in the near future. In light of Atmos's statement, Commission Staff suggested that the parties may wish to consider entering into an agreement wherein the parties would agree that Atmos would file a rate adjustment case by a date certain and that the AG would move to dismiss his Complaint. Mr. Randy Hutchinson, attorney for Atmos, stated that he would like to have the opportunity to meet briefly with his client in private. The participants all agreed and Atmos briefly left the room.

Upon returning to the room, Mr. Hutchinson thanked the participants for the opportunity to meet with his client and stated that he was not prepared to agree to his client filing a rate case at this time. He stated that he would continue to discuss the matter with Mr. Howard.

The discussions then returned to the AG's proposed procedural schedule. After a thorough discussion, the representatives of Atmos and the AG agreed to the procedural scheduled appended hereto as Appendix D, which provides for a hearing to be scheduled after January 19, 2007. The parties also agreed that an opportunity to file post-hearing briefs should be included in the procedural schedule.

Ms. Mitchell asked the parties if they would be interested in transmitting and receiving all filings by electronic mail as well as regular mail. Mr. Spenard of the AG's office suggested that text documents be transmitted in Microsoft Word<sup>®</sup> format, spreadsheets be transmitted in Microsoft<sup>®</sup> Excel format and that all other documents be transmitted in portable document format ("PDF"). All participants agreed. The AG's office asked if it would be necessary for it to file an original and 10 copies of documents in this case. Staff indicated that the parties should only be responsible for filing an original and 5 copies of all documents except testimony for which they should be required to file an original and 8 copies.

All participants stating they had no further issues to discuss, the conference was adjourned.
