ORDER

This matter arises upon the motion for full intervention of the Kentucky Cable Telecommunications Association ("KCTA") on behalf of three of its members, Big Sandy TV Cable, Charter Communications, and Inter Mountain Cable. It appears to the Commission that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. The Commission also recognizes that a procedural schedule was established in this proceeding by Order dated July 8, 2005. The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that the KCTA should be granted full rights of a party in this proceeding and that KCTA should abide by the current procedural schedule.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The motion of the KCTA to intervene is granted, and the KCTA shall abide by the existing procedural schedule.
- 2. The KCTA shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.

3. Should the KCTA file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, it shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
