## NOTICE OF AMENDMENT OF PETITION

Northern Kentucky Water District (NKWD), by counsel, gives notice that it is amending its Petition in this proceeding to withdraw those portions of the rate application that relate to a request for a multi-year rate mechanism.

- 1. The District withdraws any reference to and request for any adjustment in rates for any year except the initial year of the proposed rate adjustment.
- 2. The District continues to seek an adjustment in rates for the first year of the proposed rate increase as reflected in the cost of service study, but not for any subsequent year as originally proposed.
- 3. Specifically, the District withdraws Schedules E, F and G contained in the Executive Summary of the cost of service study as well as Schedules 20, 20.1 and 21 of Appendix C and Appendix D of the COS and the rates associated with those schedules, as well as the testimony in support of the multi-year proposal.
- 4. The withdrawal of the multi-year rate mechanism proposal does not affect the request for issuance of bonds or construction of facilities.
  - 5. The withdrawal of the multi-year proposal simplifies the rate adjustment

proposed by allowing rates to be established exclusively on the test year and adjustments, rather than on the expected expenses and revenue requirements of the subsequent four years.

6. All other adjustments, exhibits, testimony and supporting schedules remain unchanged by this modification to the application.
