

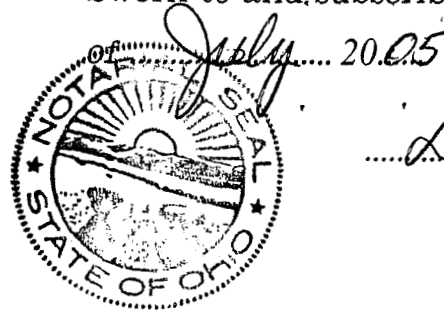

The average customer bill will increase from \$78.66 per quarter to \$86.05 per quarter. In addition to these rates, NKWD is proposing a mechanism to adjust its rates annually to reflect the additional cost of financing of its capital projects. If approved by the Commission, the District will adjust its rates annually by an amount approved by the FSC and customer rates increase to reflect this additional amount. NKWD estimates that this annual increase in rates will be approximately 4.2% in year 2, 6.0% in year 3, 5% in year 4, and 3.9% in year 5 after the initial rate increase. Please note that the rates are stated in hundred cubic feet. Further information may be obtained from the Commission or the NKWD. The rates proposed in this Notice may be modified by the Commission. Such action by the Commission may result in the rates being higher or lower than those proposed by the NKWD.

Any corporation, association, body public or person may by timely motion, within 30 days of this Notice, request intervention in this case. Intervention beyond the 30 day period may be granted if a good cause is shown. The Motion must be submitted to the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Blvd., Box 615, Frankfort, Ky. 40602 and should state the grounds for the request, including the interest status of the party.
