COME the Concerned Citizens Against the Power Line Extension ("Citizens")¹, by counsel, and move this commission to grant full intervenor status in the above referenced matter, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(8) and request for a public hearing. In support hereof, the Citizens state as follows:

This case concerns the proposed construction by Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") of a 138,000 volt electric transmission line from KU's West Frankfort substation in Franklin County to KU's Tyrone generating station in Woodford County. KU notified affected property

owners of the proposed construction of the electric transmission line on May 9, 2005. KU's application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the Construction of Transmission Facilities in Franklin, Woodford and Anderson Counties, Kentucky was filed with the Public Service Commission on May 11, 2005.

As these Citizens own property that will be directly impacted by construction of this transmission line they have a special and unique interest in this proceeding which is otherwise not adequately represented.
