RE: Proposed KU transmission line from Florida Tile to West Frankfort substation


Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

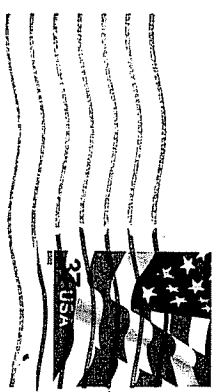
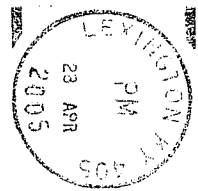
I will appreciate having my name entered into your file when any application is made.
